Utah State University Graduate & Professional Student Survey

Report of Findings

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Overview

The Utah State University implementation of the Ithaca S+R Graduate & Professional Student Survey was launched on November 8th, 2021, and was closed to new responses on December 13th, 2021, with a total of 365 complete responses. The questionnaire covers topics in several key areas including: students' use of assigned course materials; practices and preferences for curricular and non-curricular information discovery; the role of the library; use of library space; objectives in obtaining an advanced degree; and understanding of and interest in conducting or contributing to original research. The following report provides a high-level overview of findings from Utah State University graduate & professional student survey.

Details

3,379 Utah State University graduate and professional students received an email invitation to participate in a survey about perceptions of library resources and services. A small donation to USU's Student Nutrition Access Center (SNAC) was made per each completed survey response. Students were also entered into a lottery to win USU swag, tech items, and more as an incentive for participation. Three email reminders were sent before the close of the survey.

In total, 567 respondents clicked the survey link (about 17% of those who received the email invitation), with 506 of those starting the survey (about 15%) and 365 of those respondents completing the survey, for an overall response rate of about 11%. Due to the survey flow and skip patterns, not all Utah State University graduate and professional student respondents received every question in the survey.

How to interpret the findings

For each question in Utah State University graduate & professional student survey, this document provides a single graph and table of overall responses. Title pages provide information about survey flow and contingent items, which signify that a question was only presented to those who satisfied a condition in their response to another question.

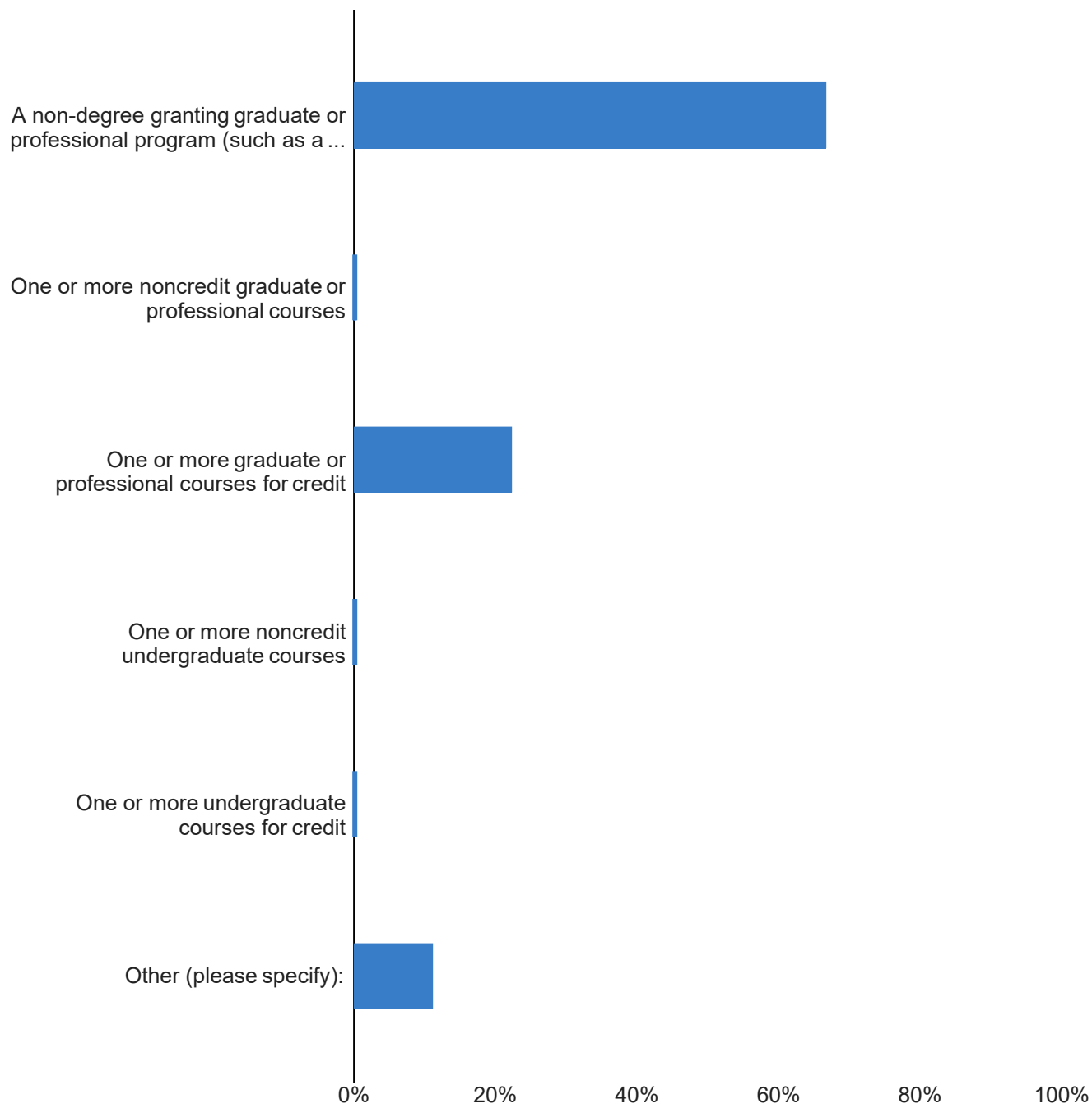

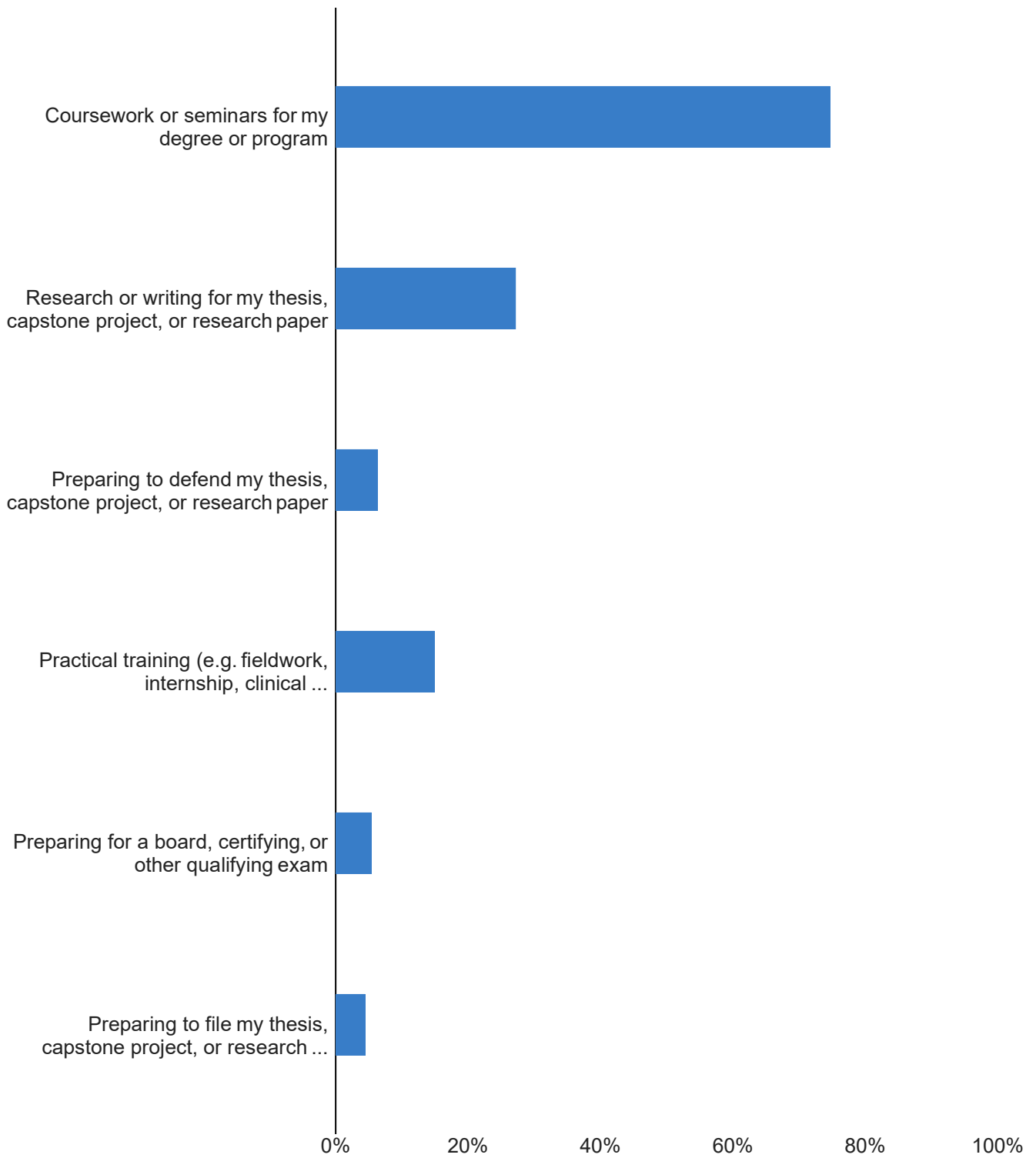

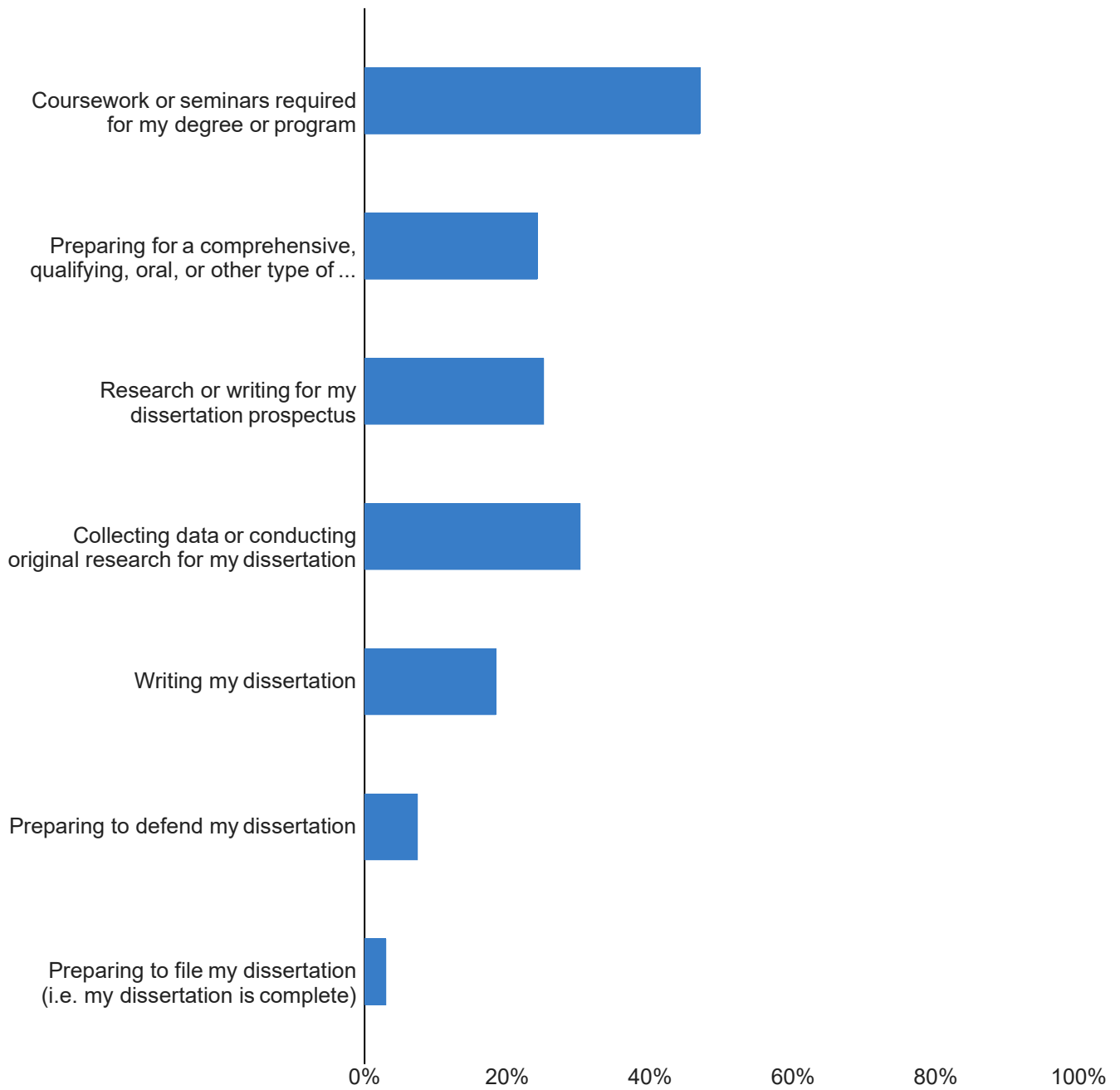

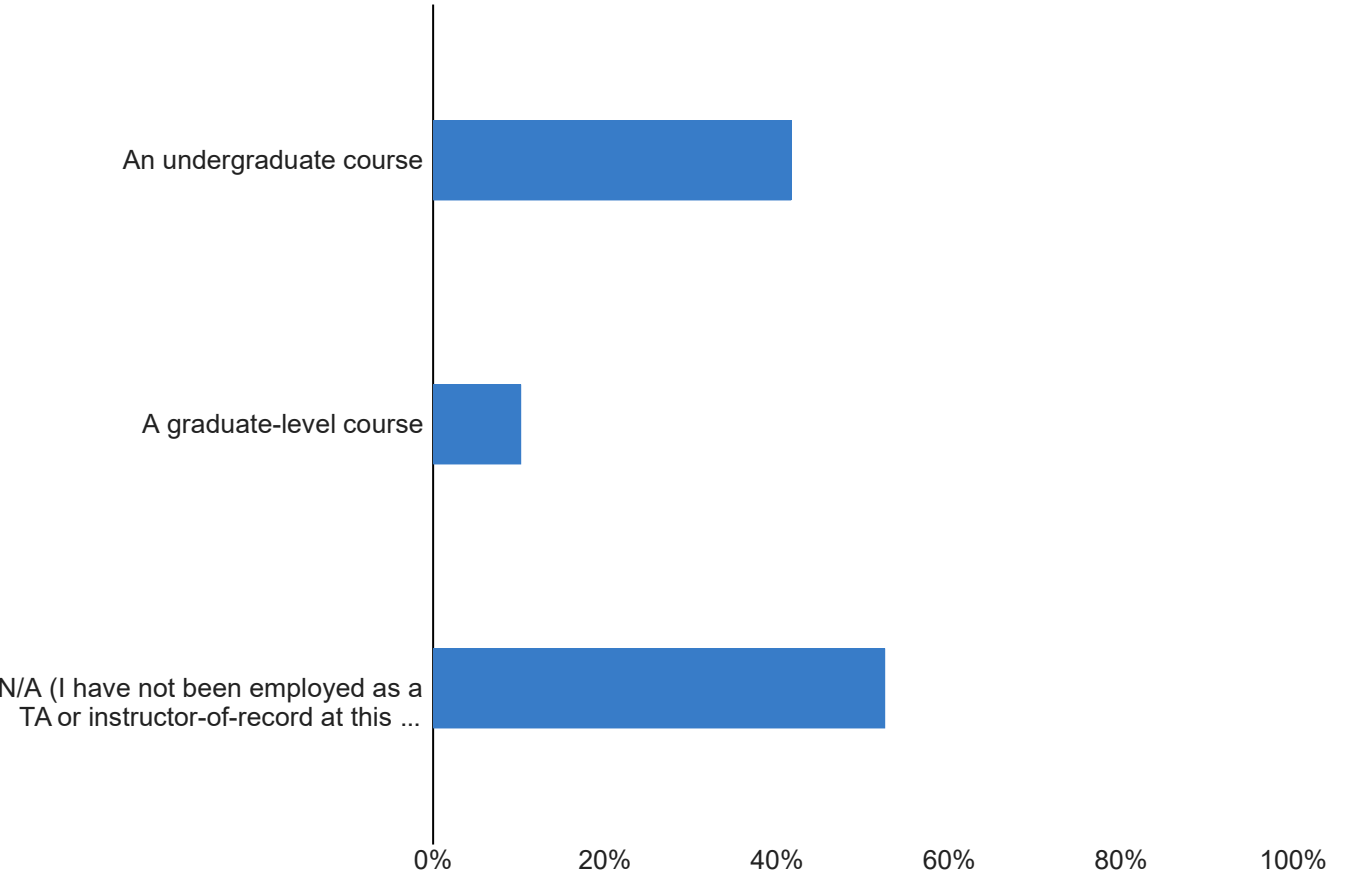

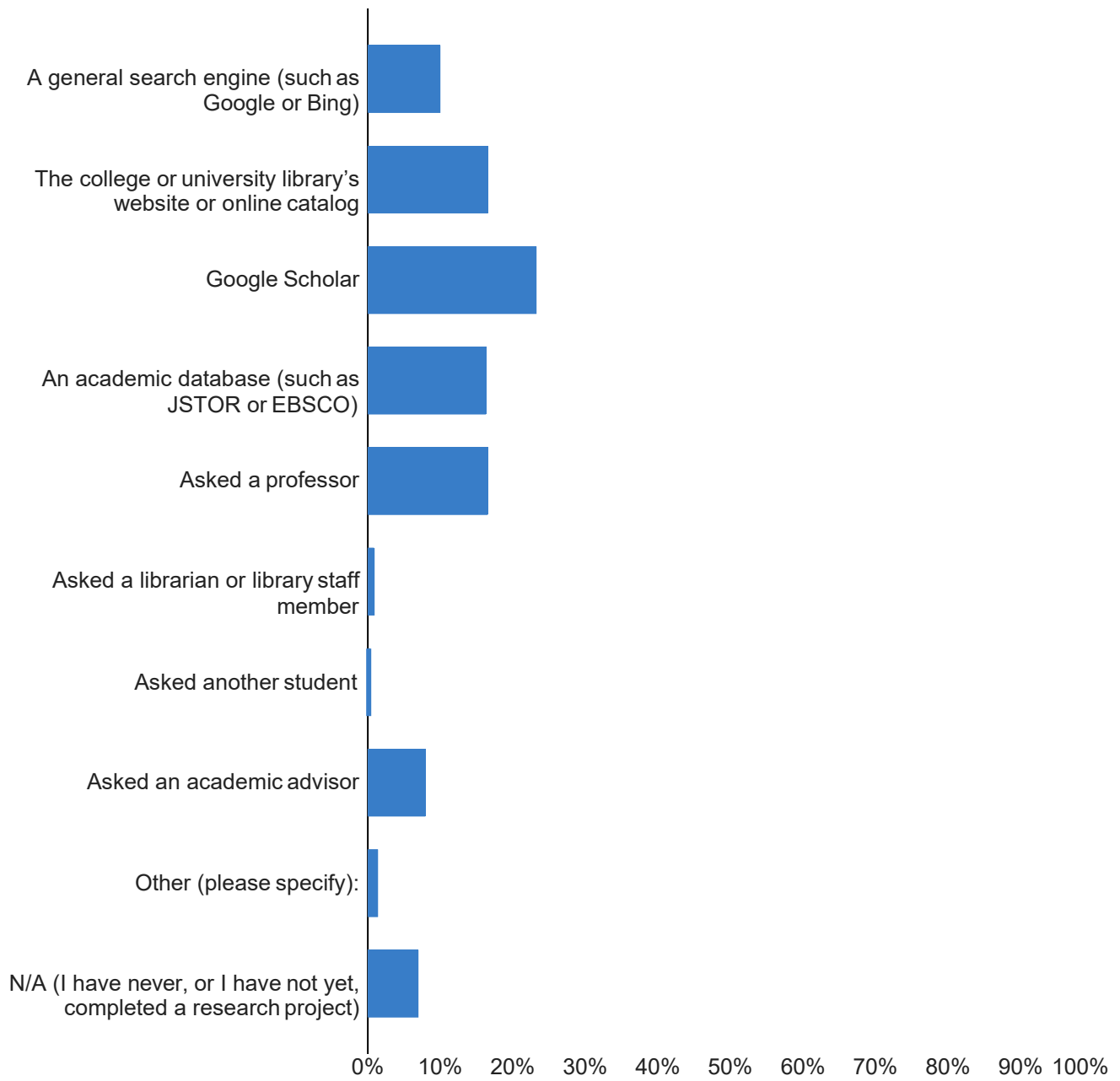

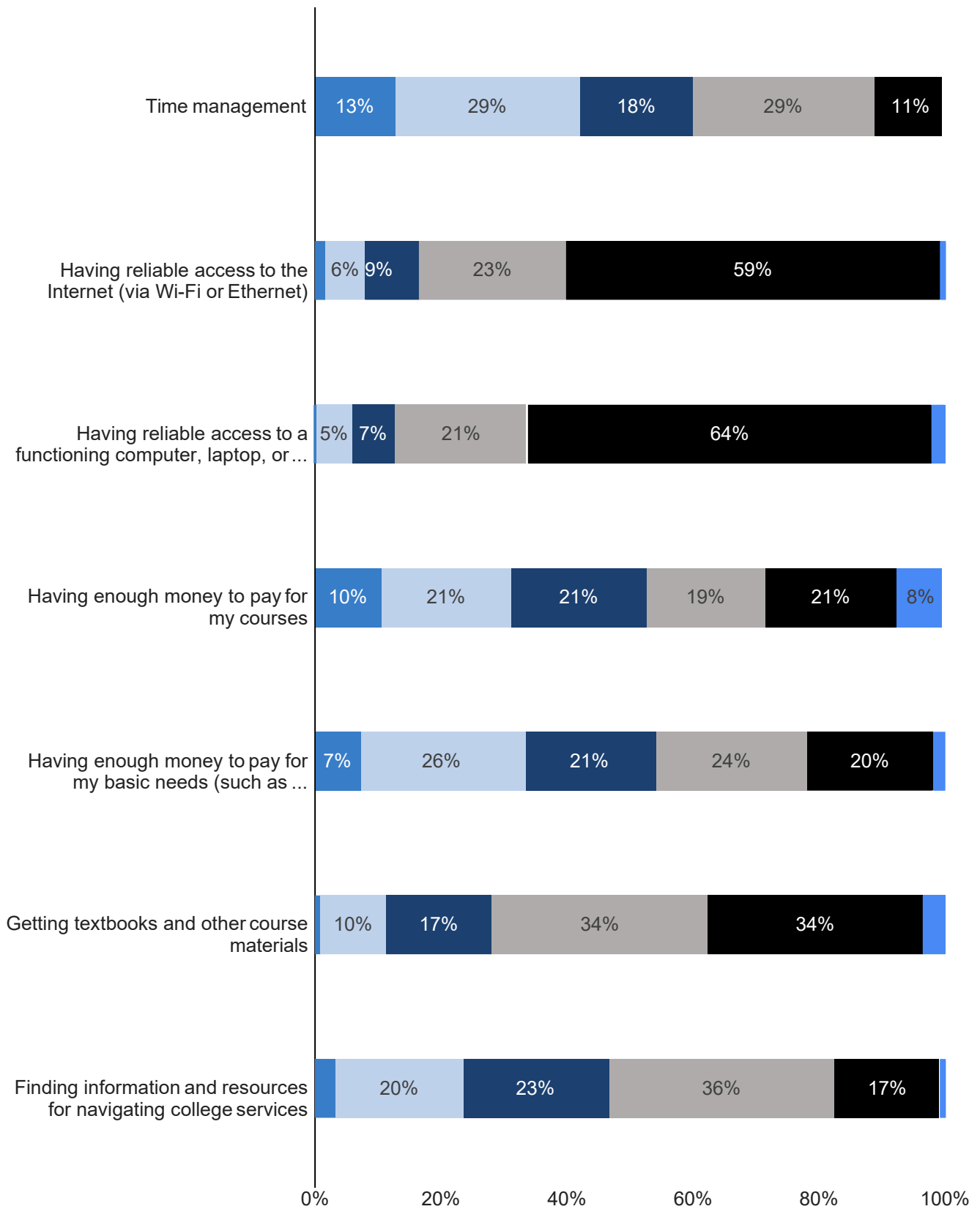

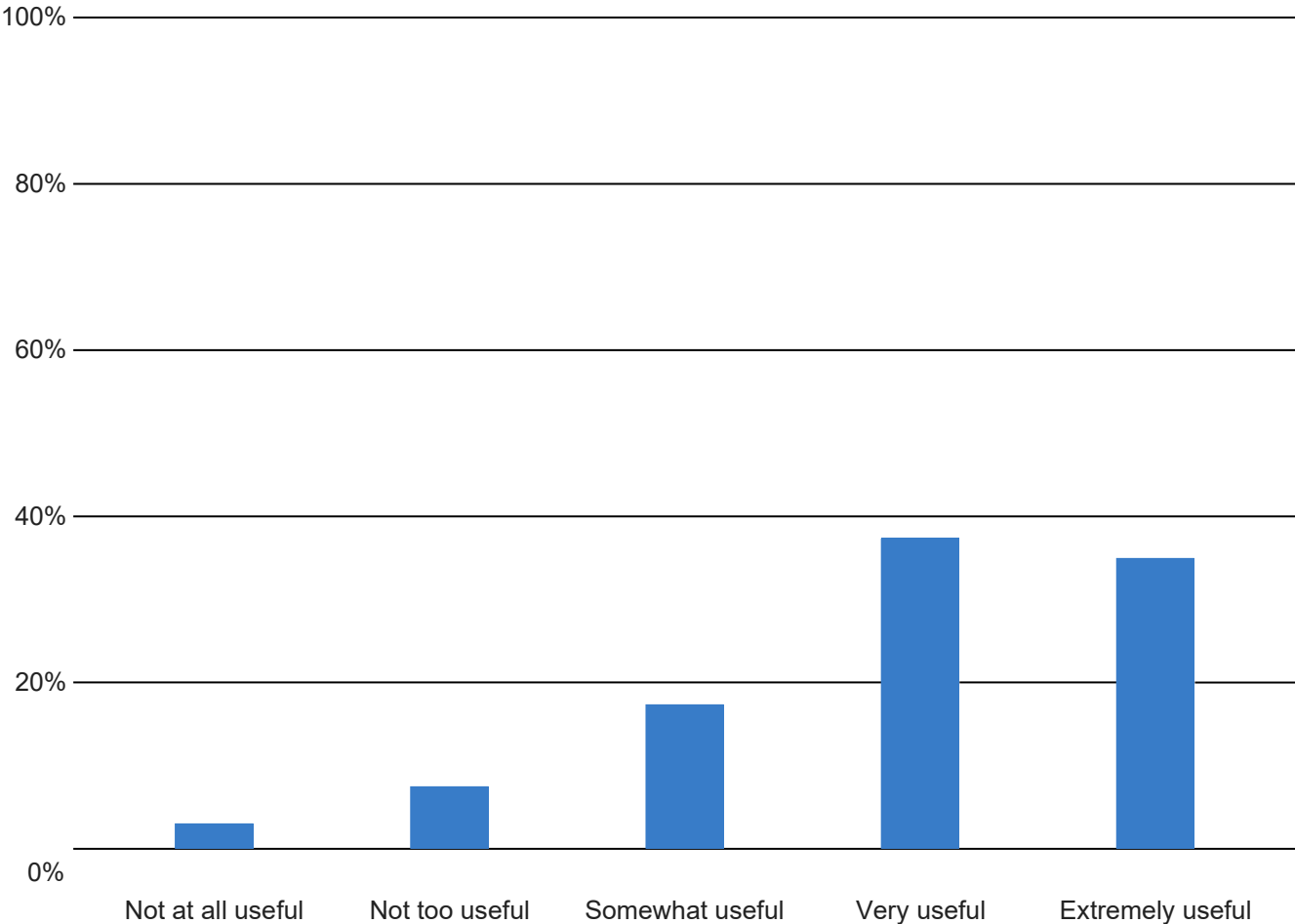

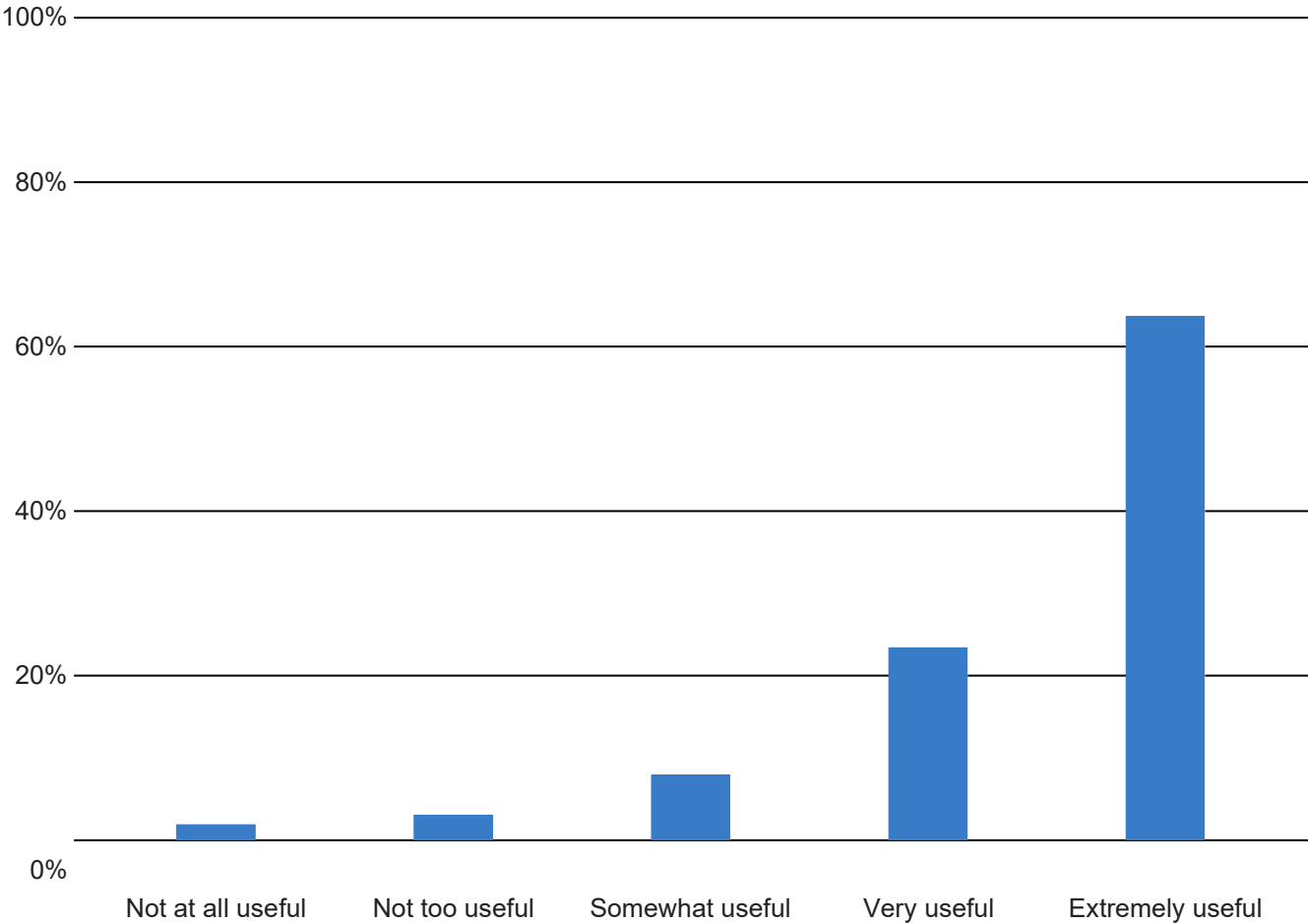

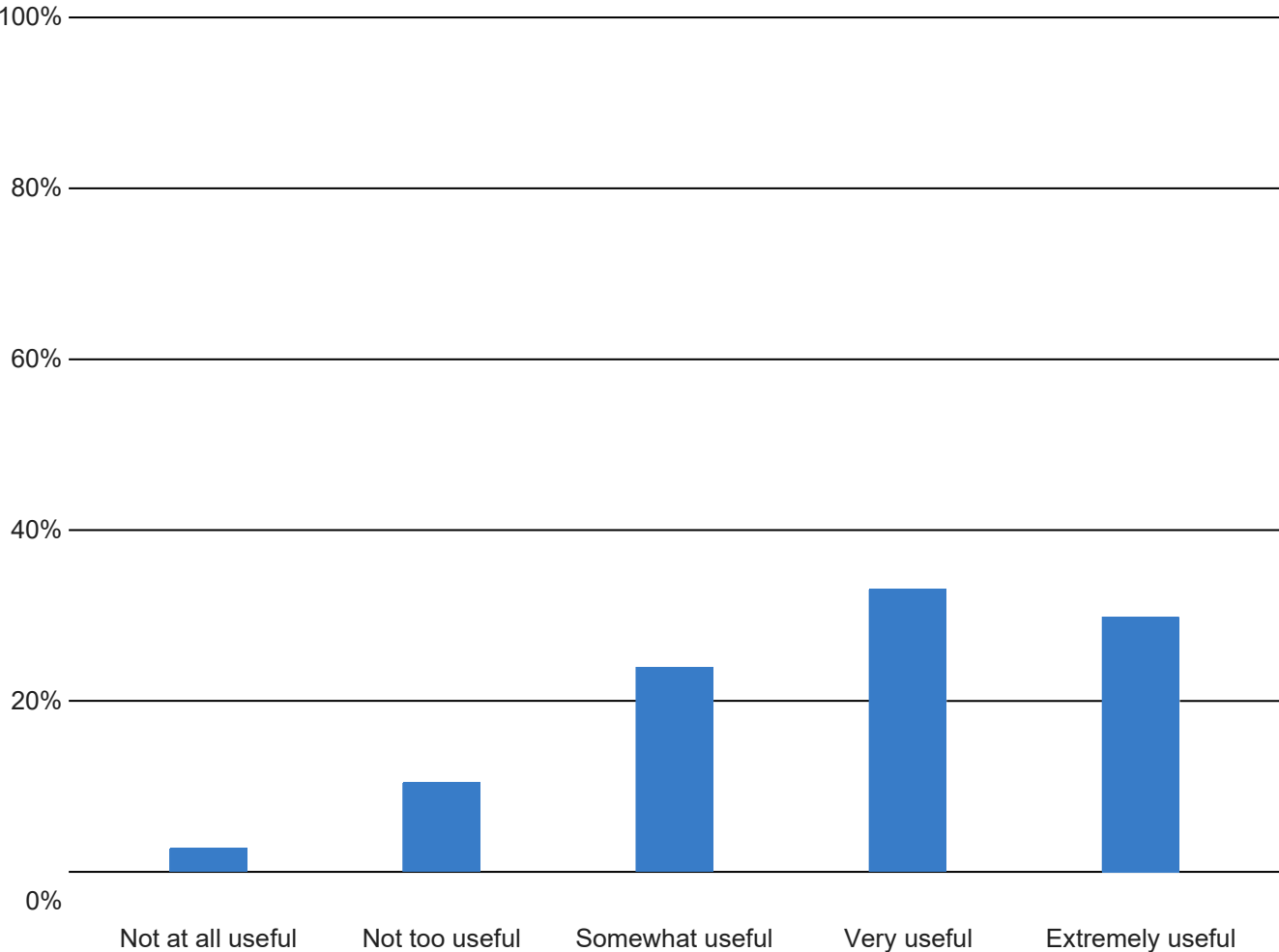

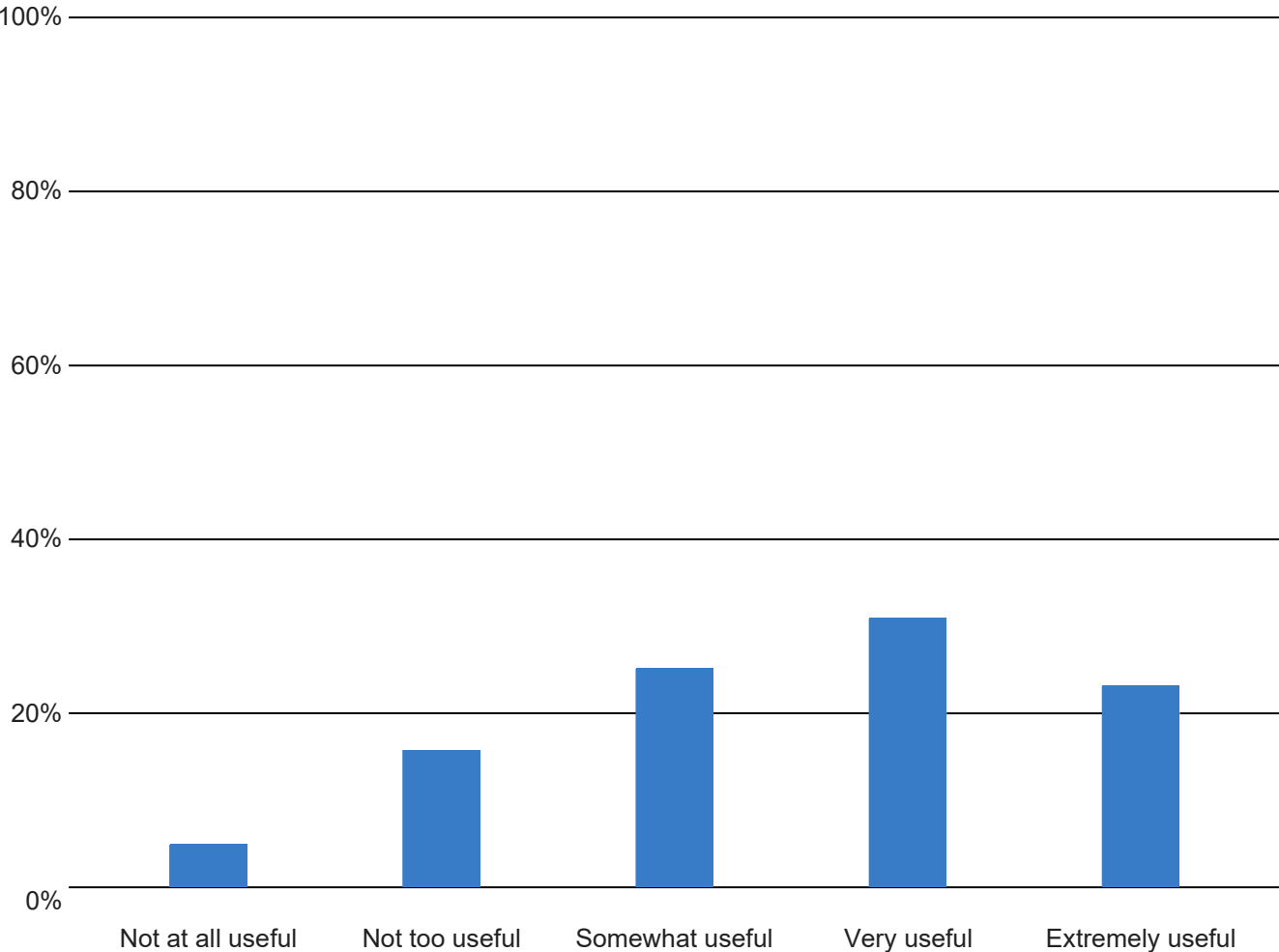

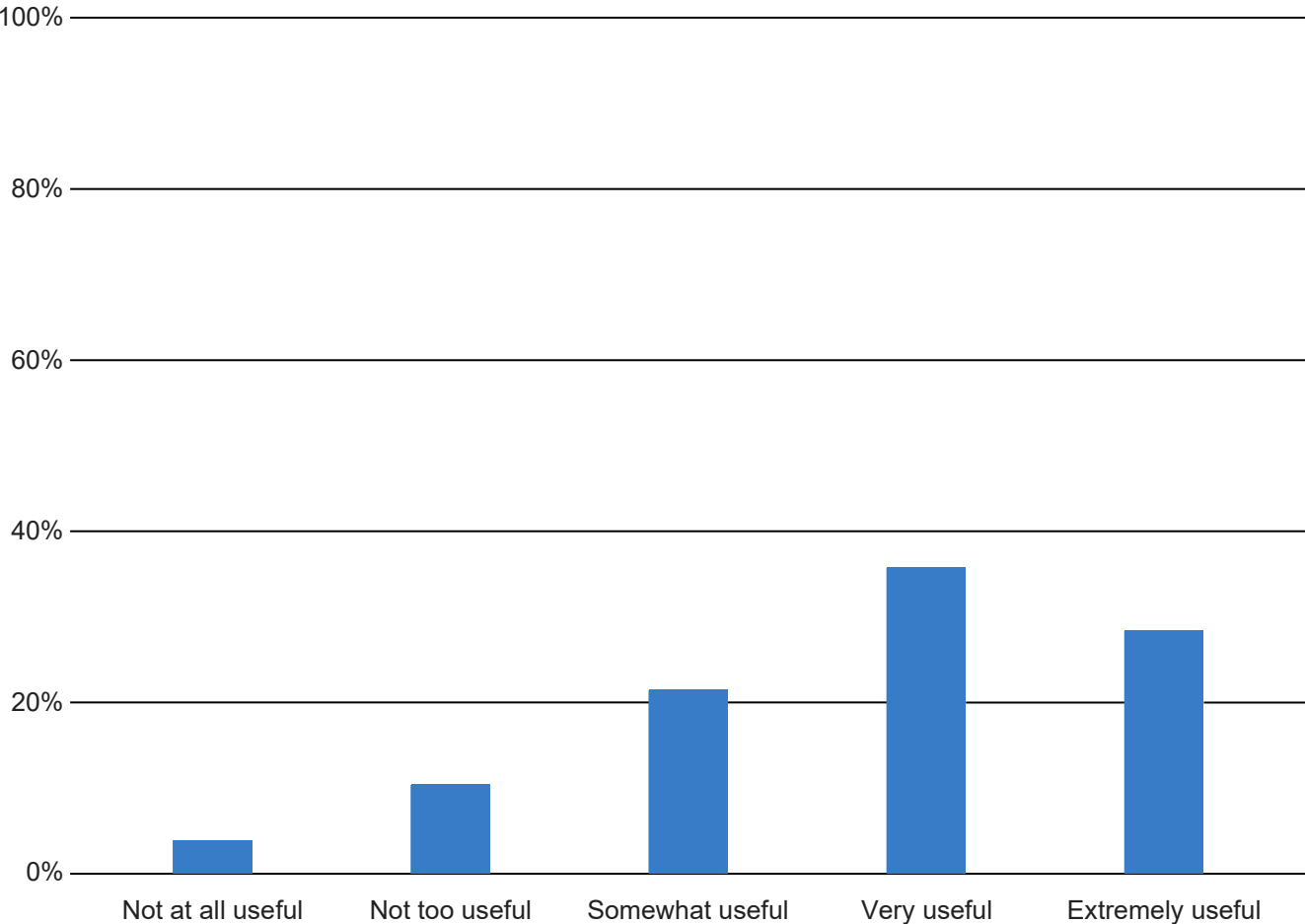

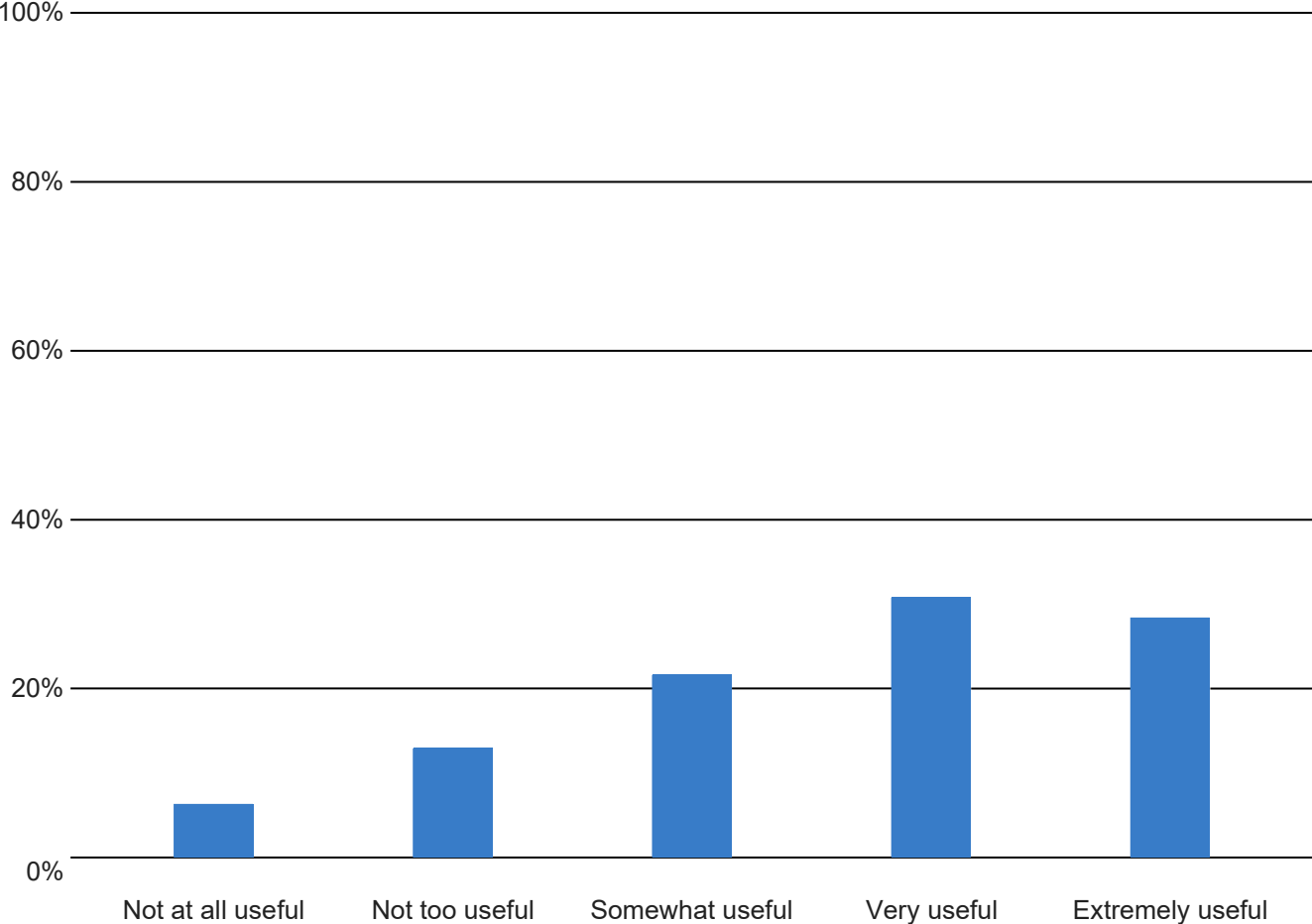

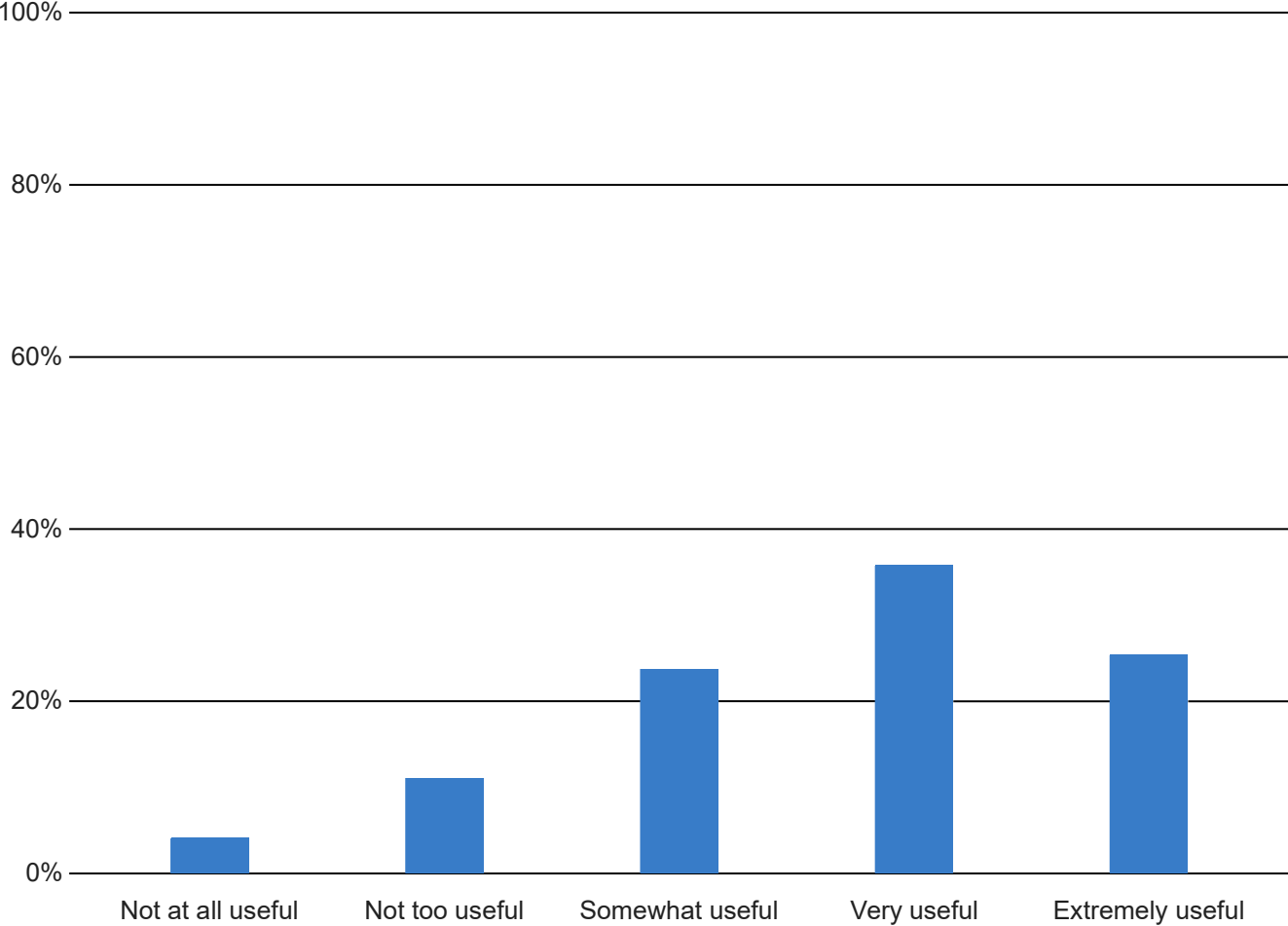

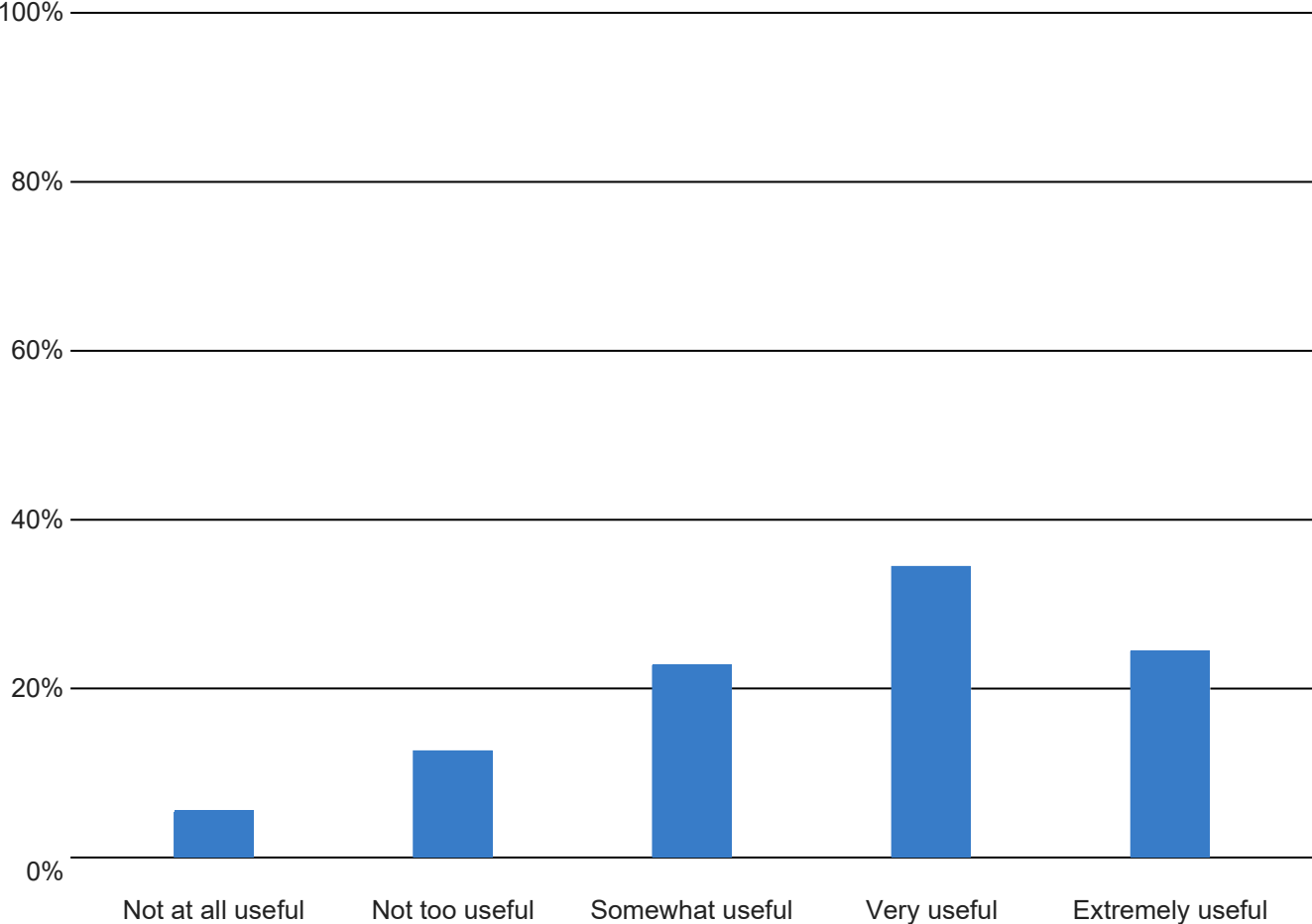

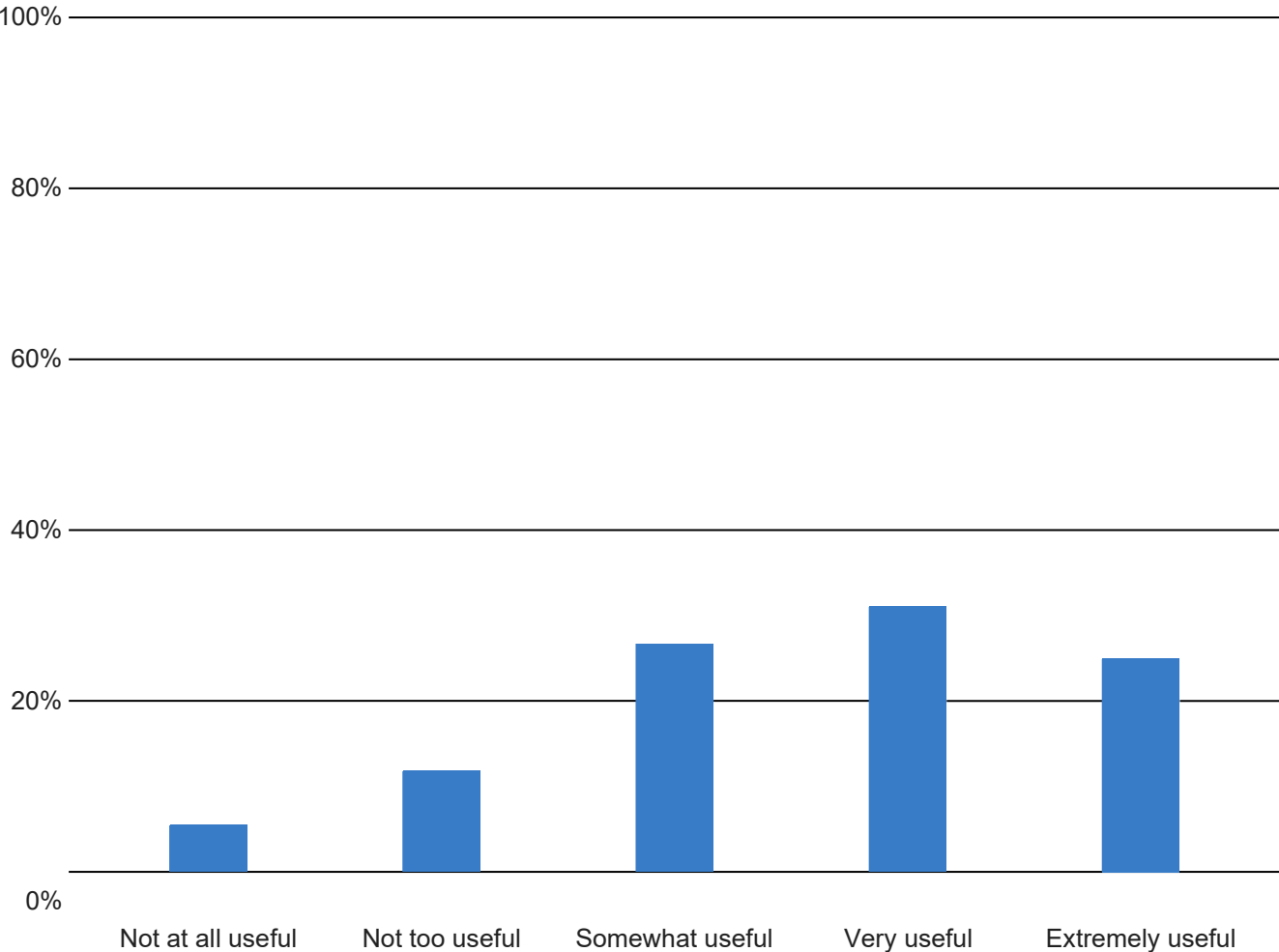

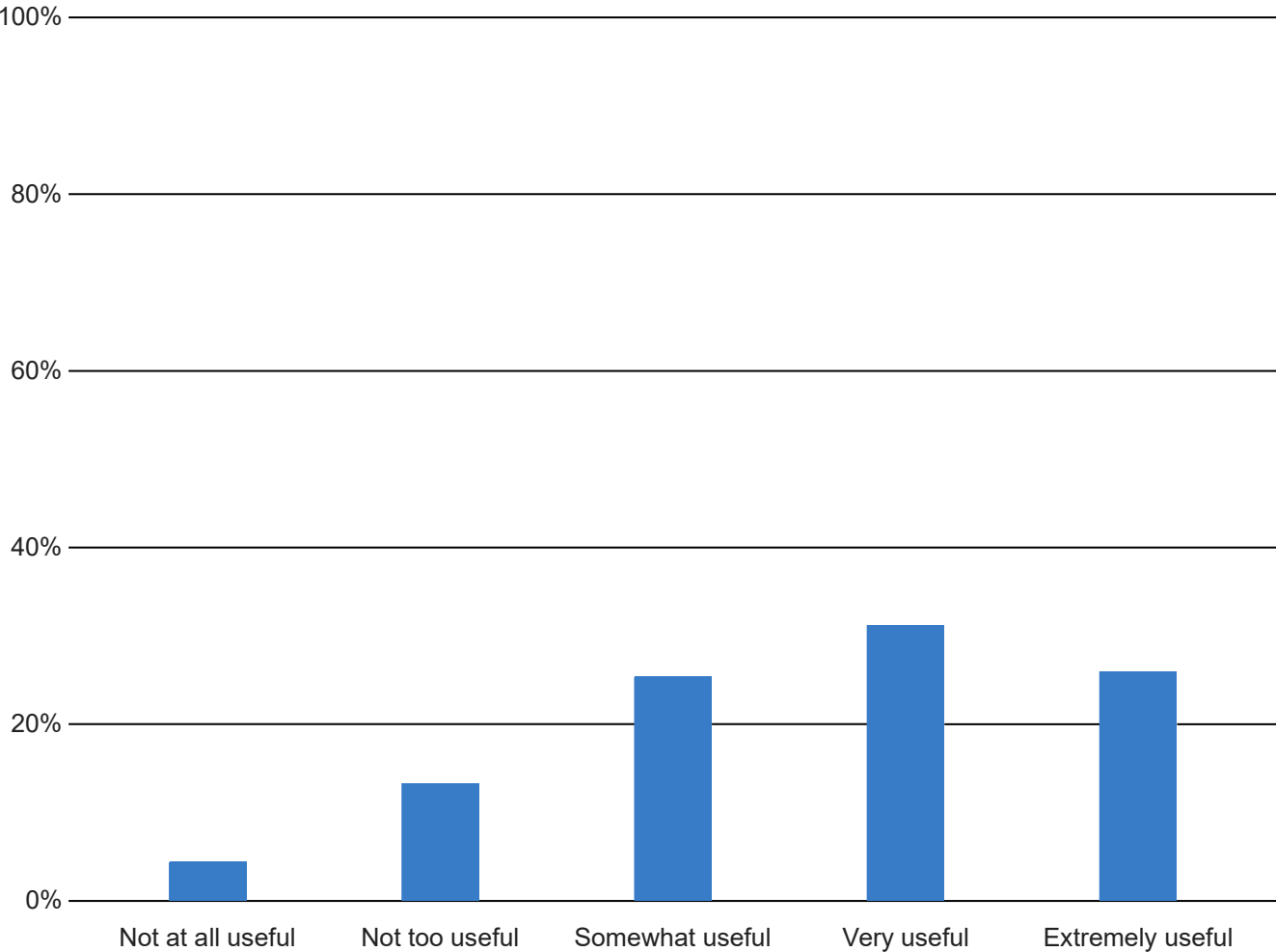

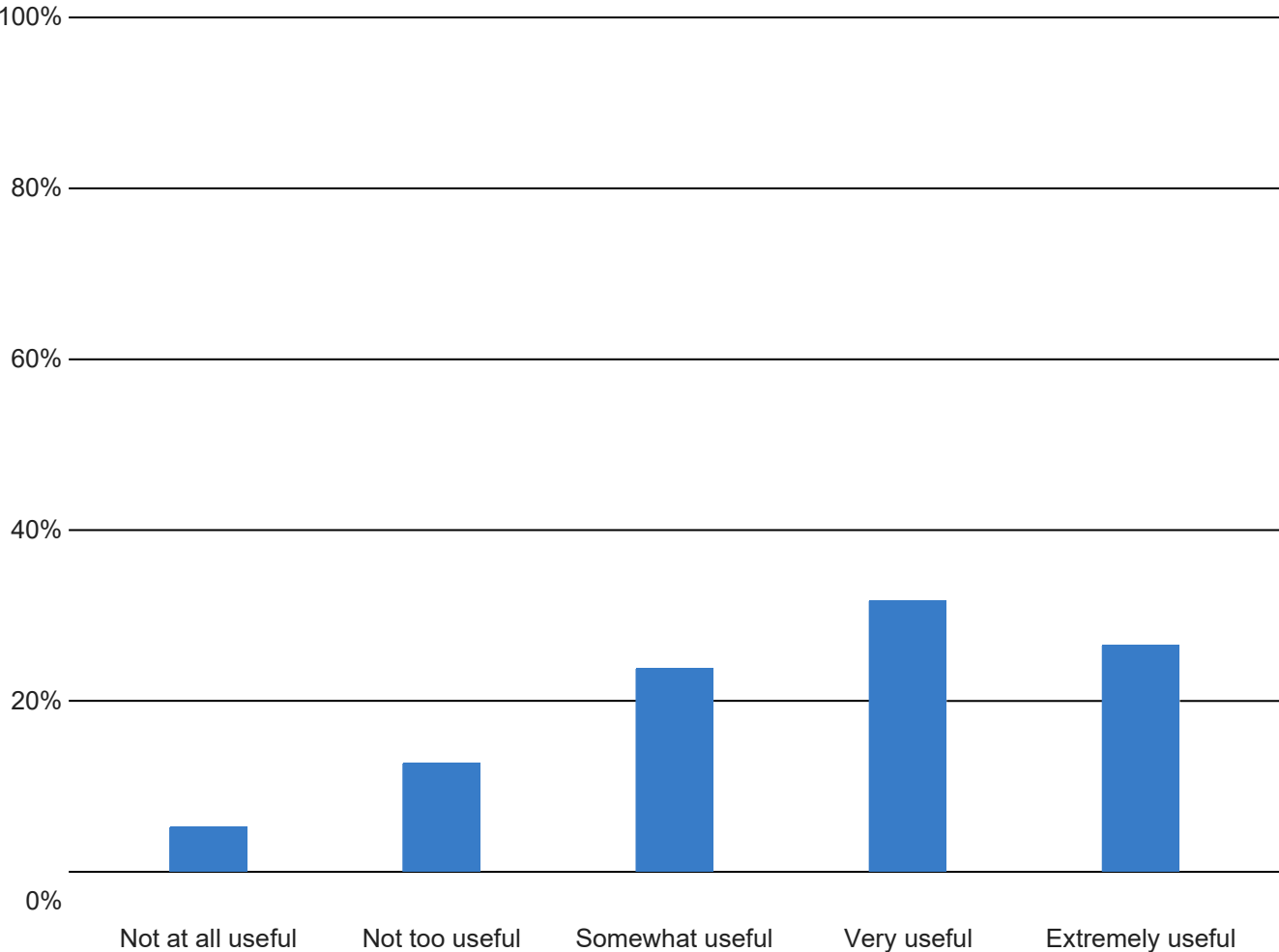

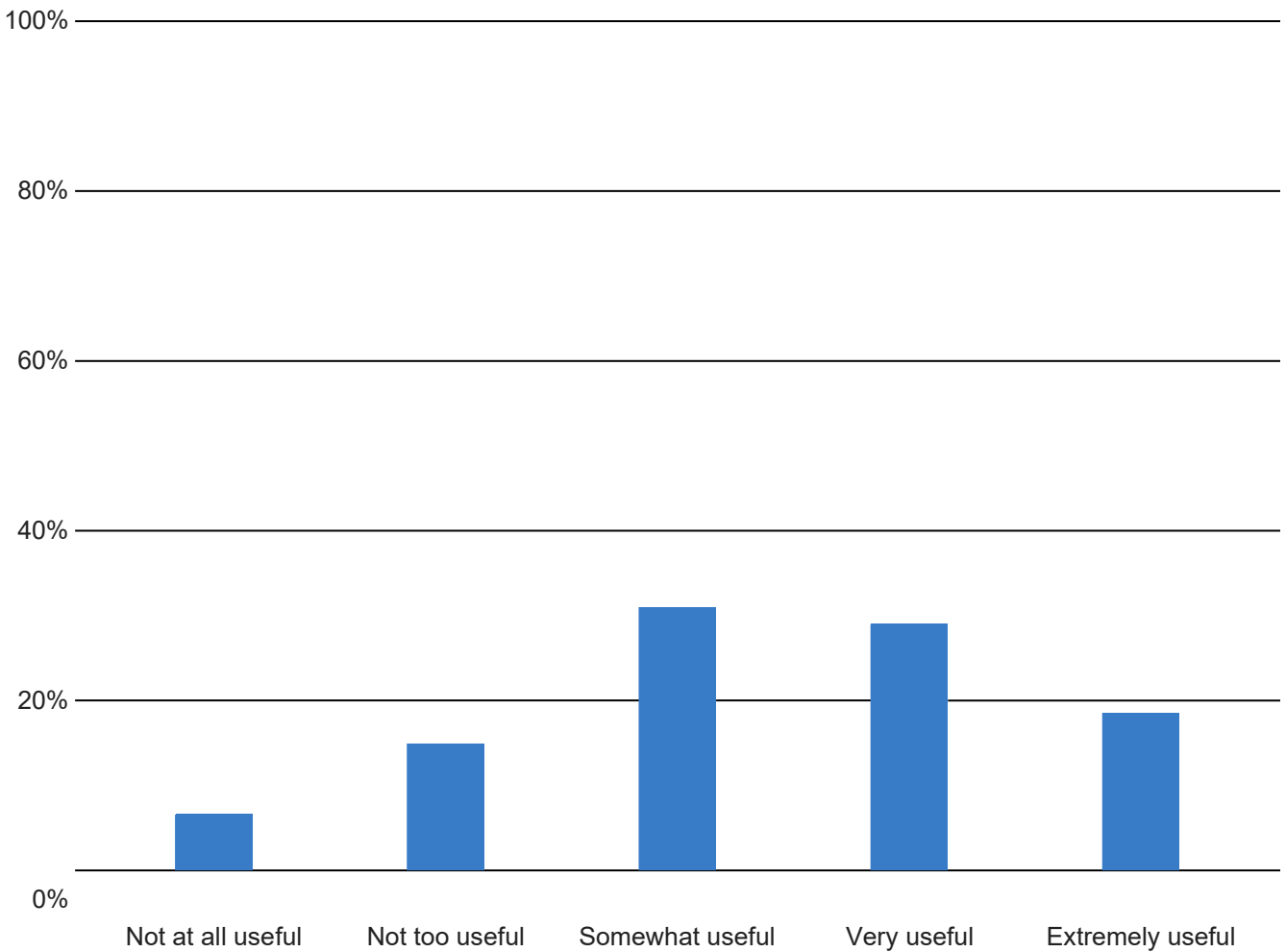

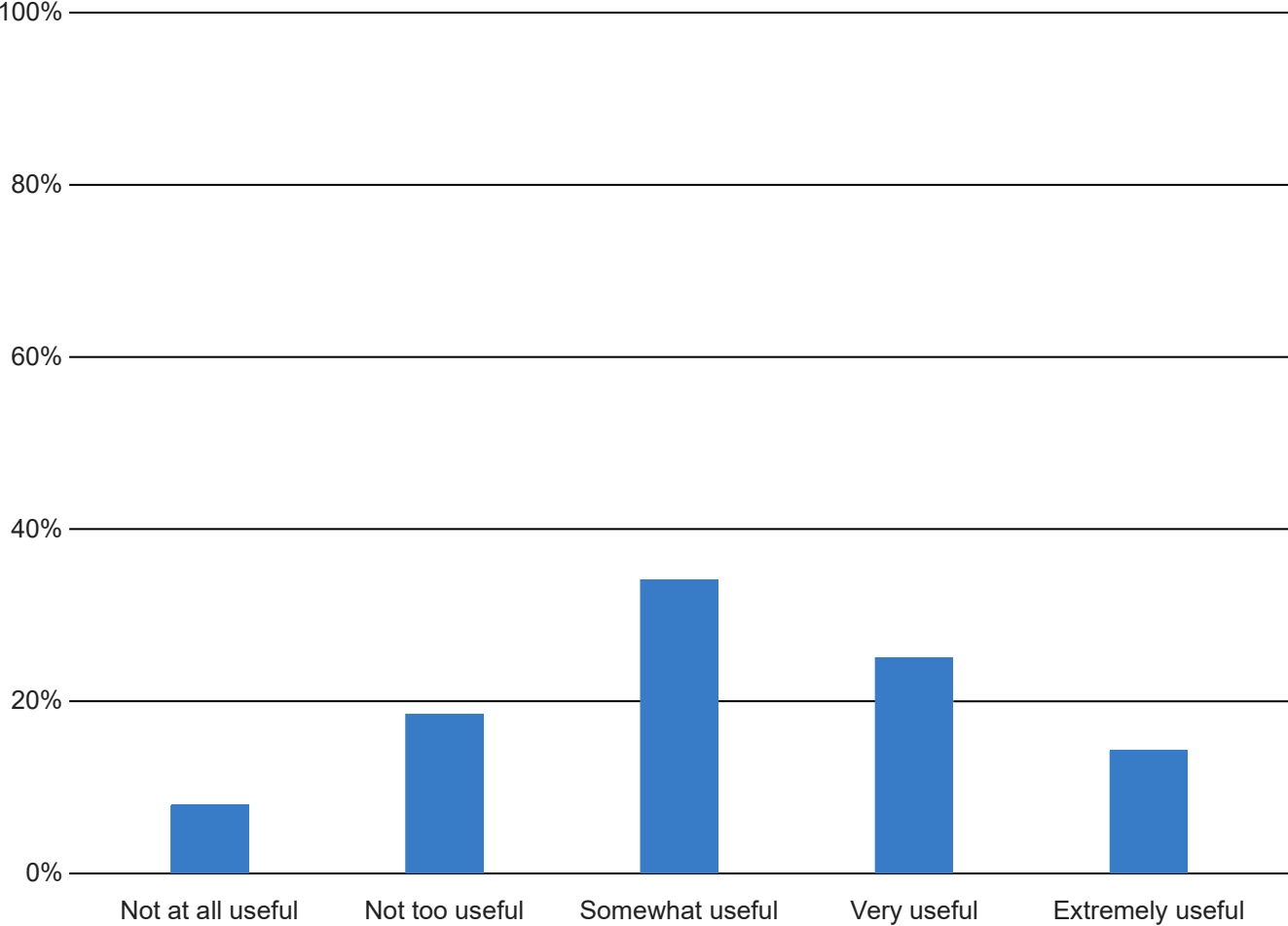

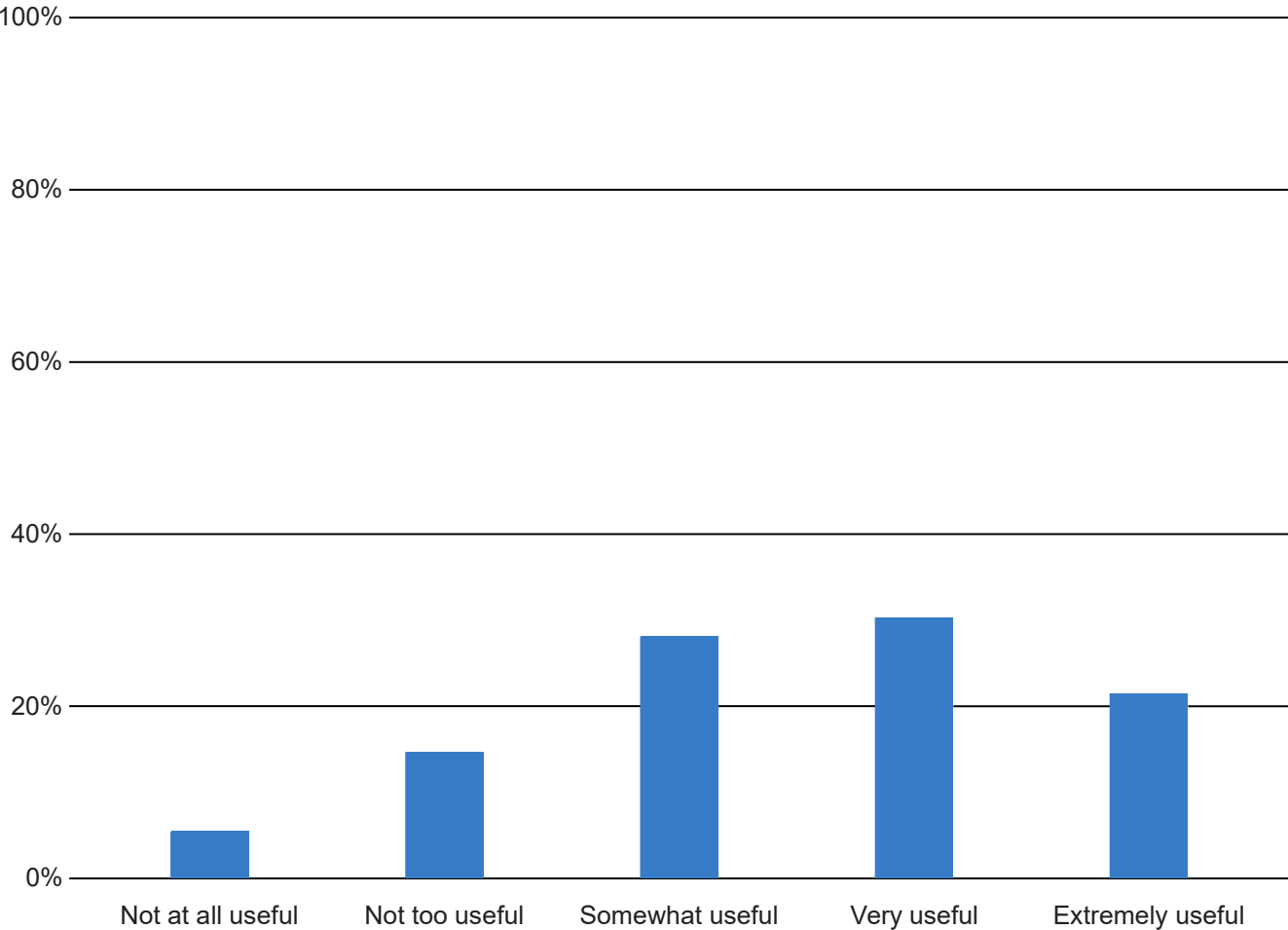

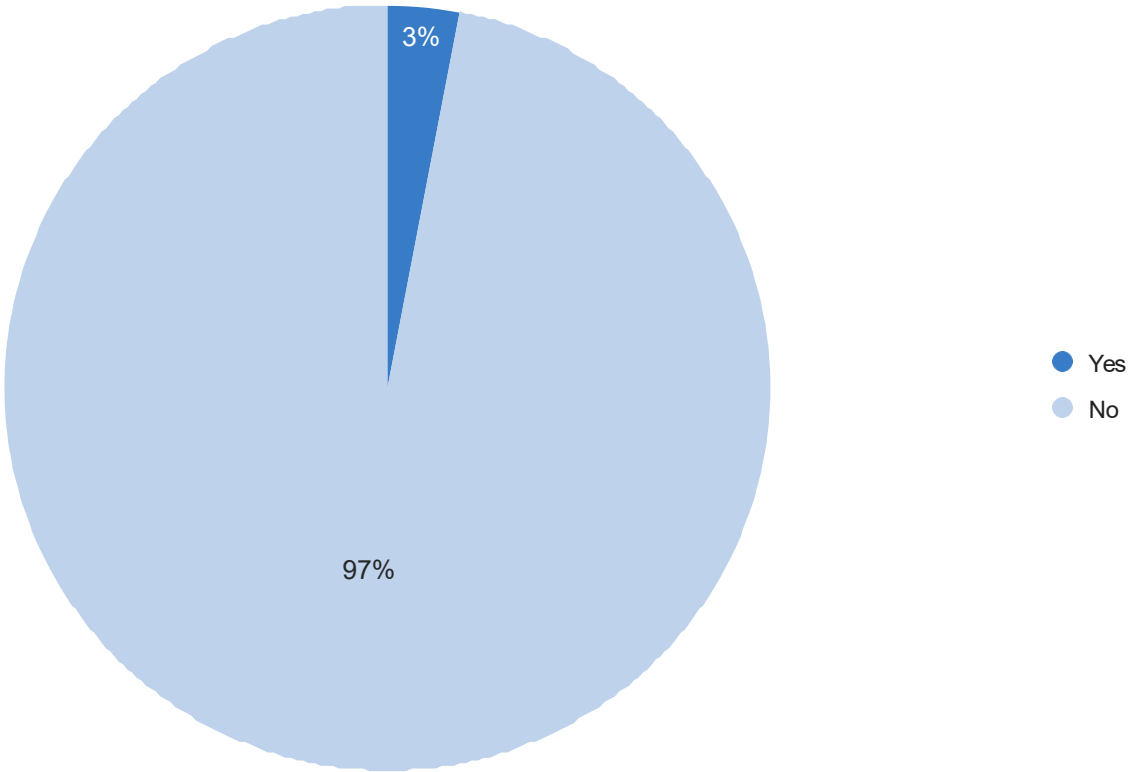

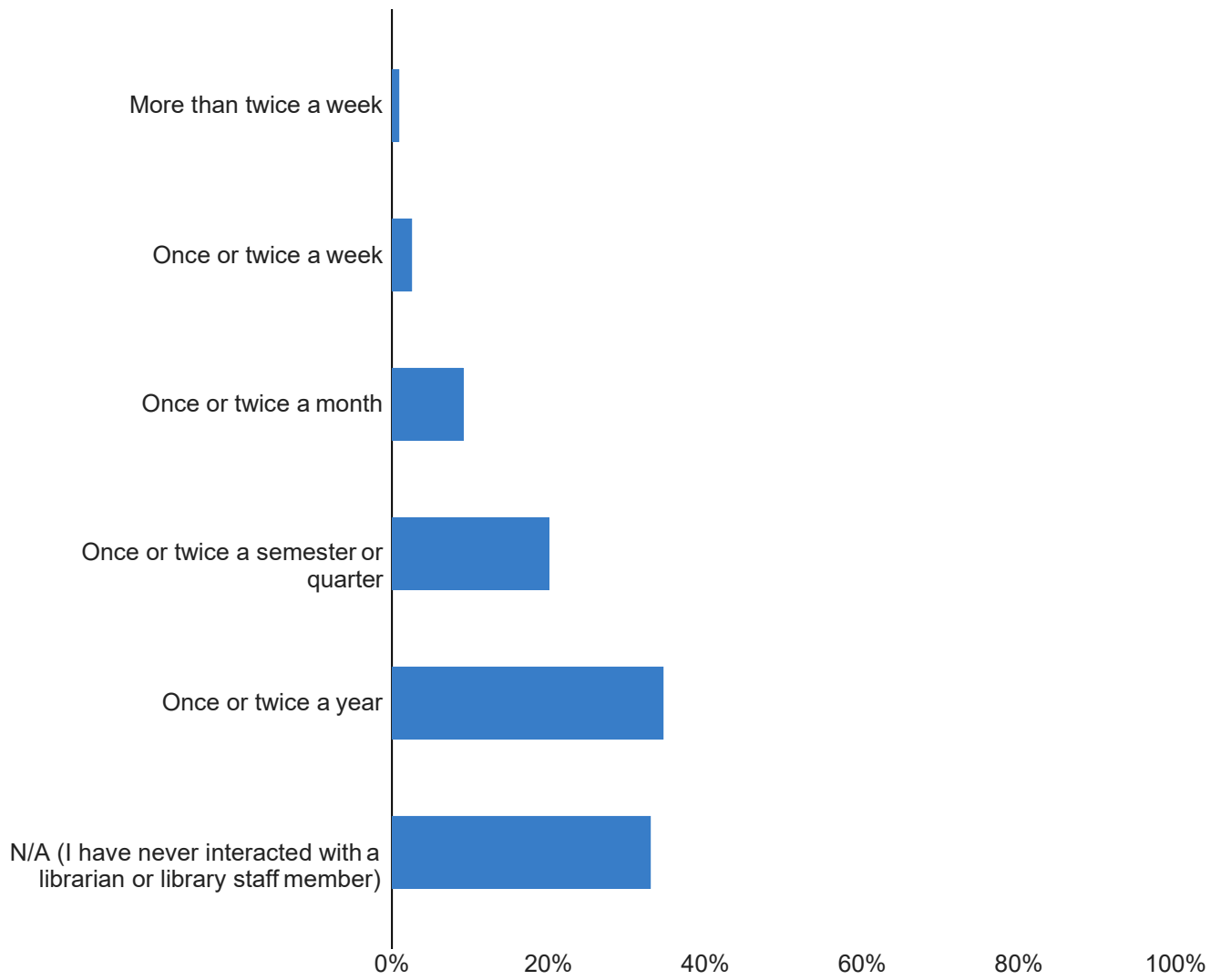

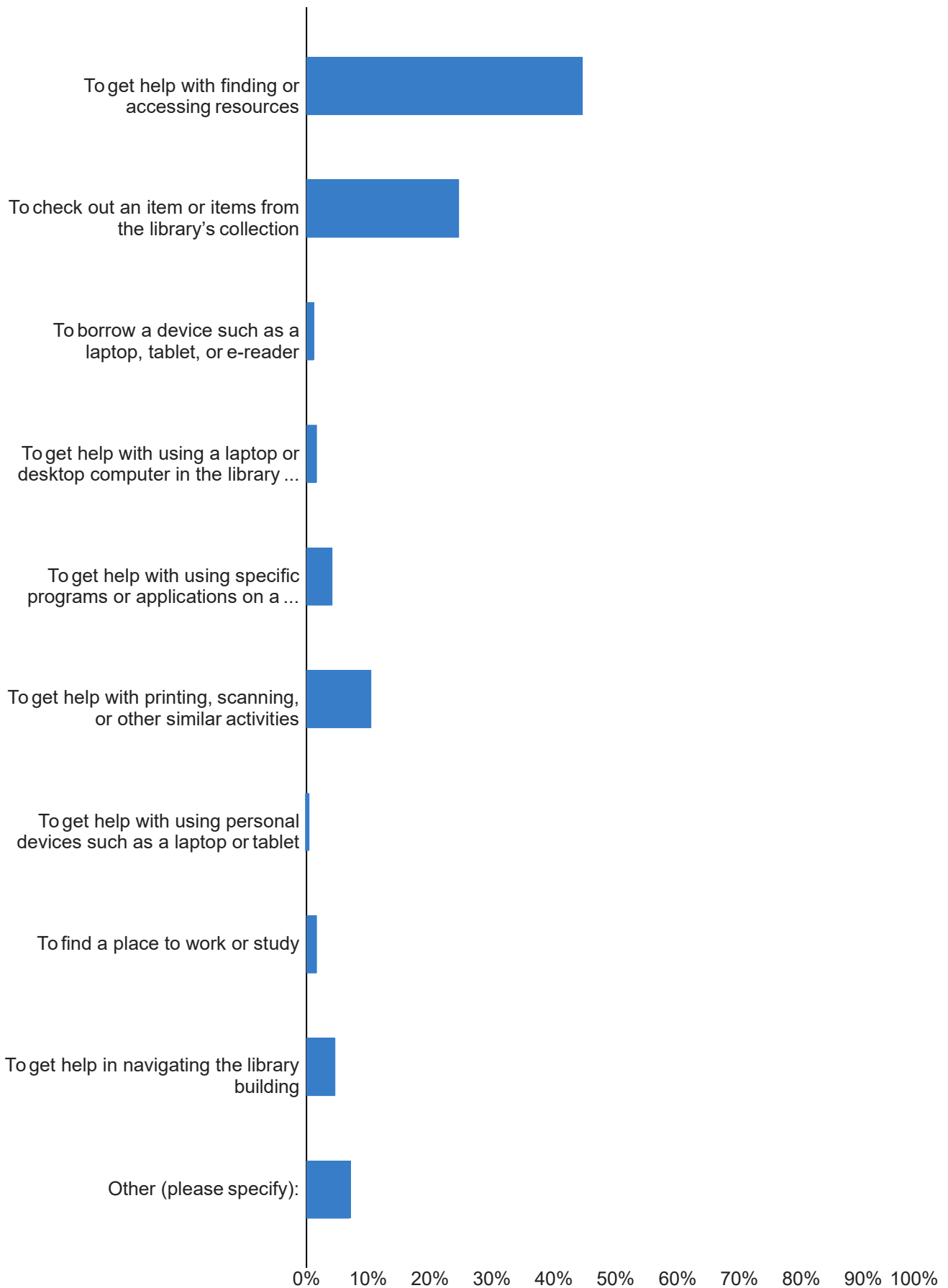

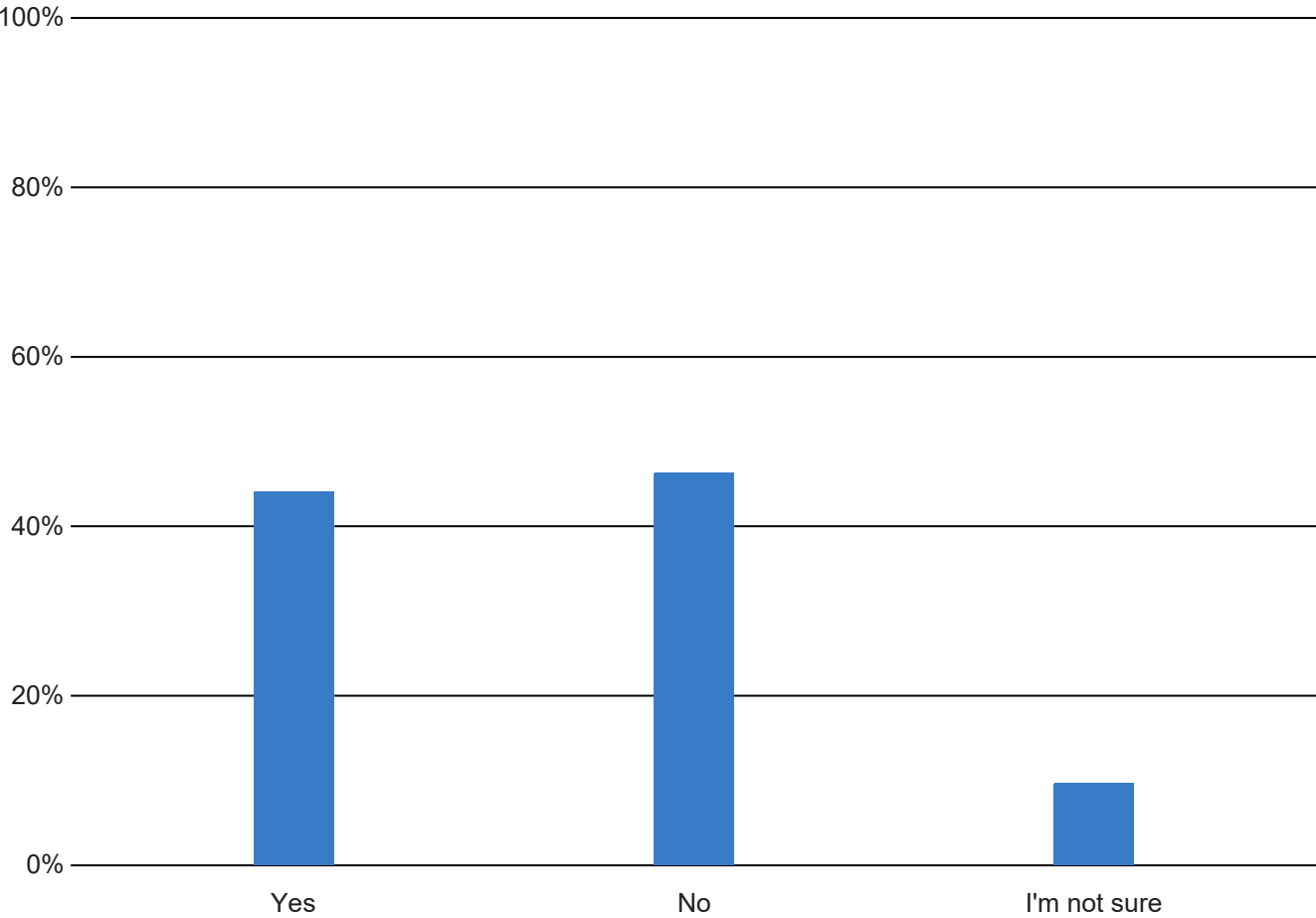

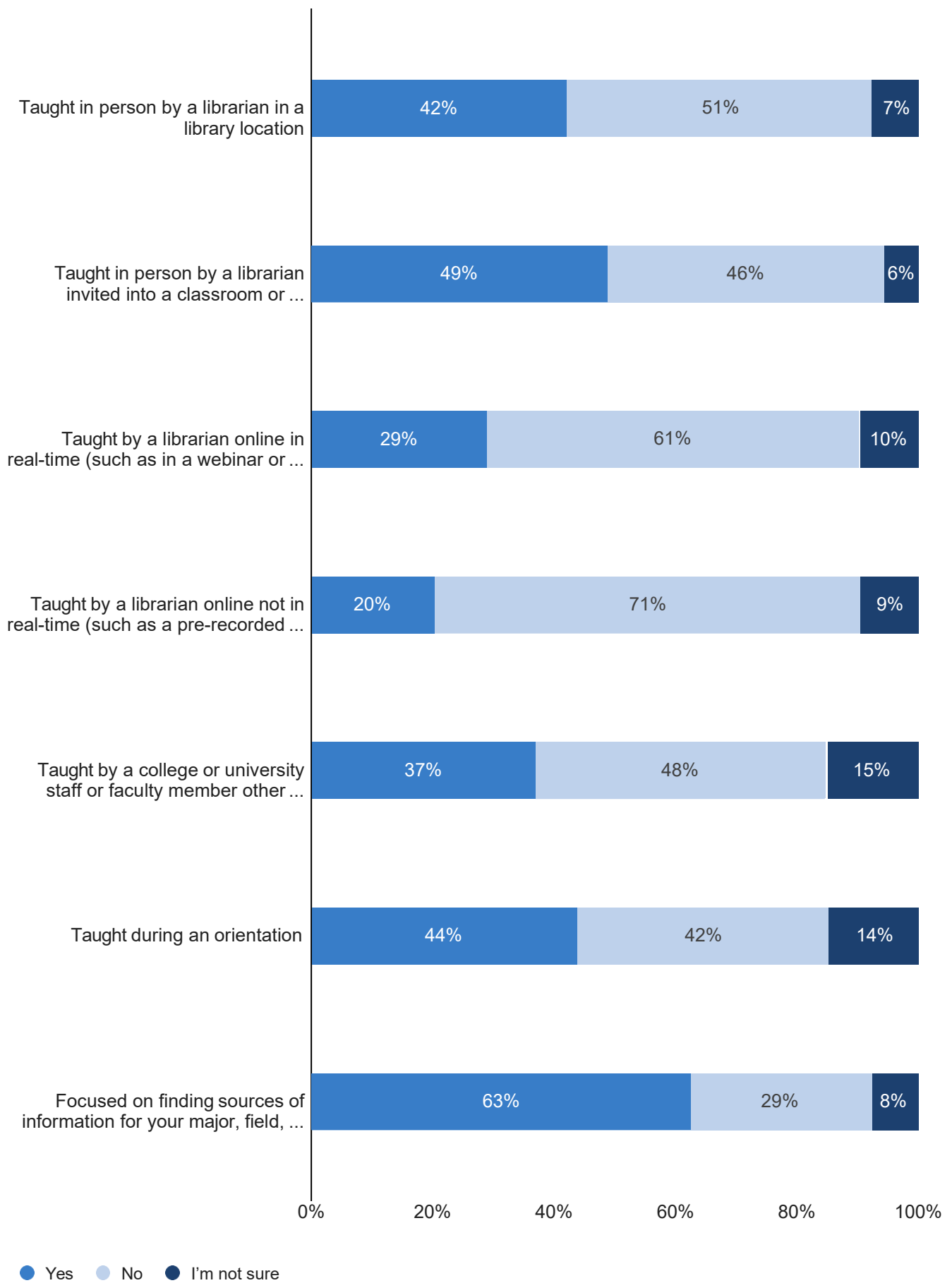

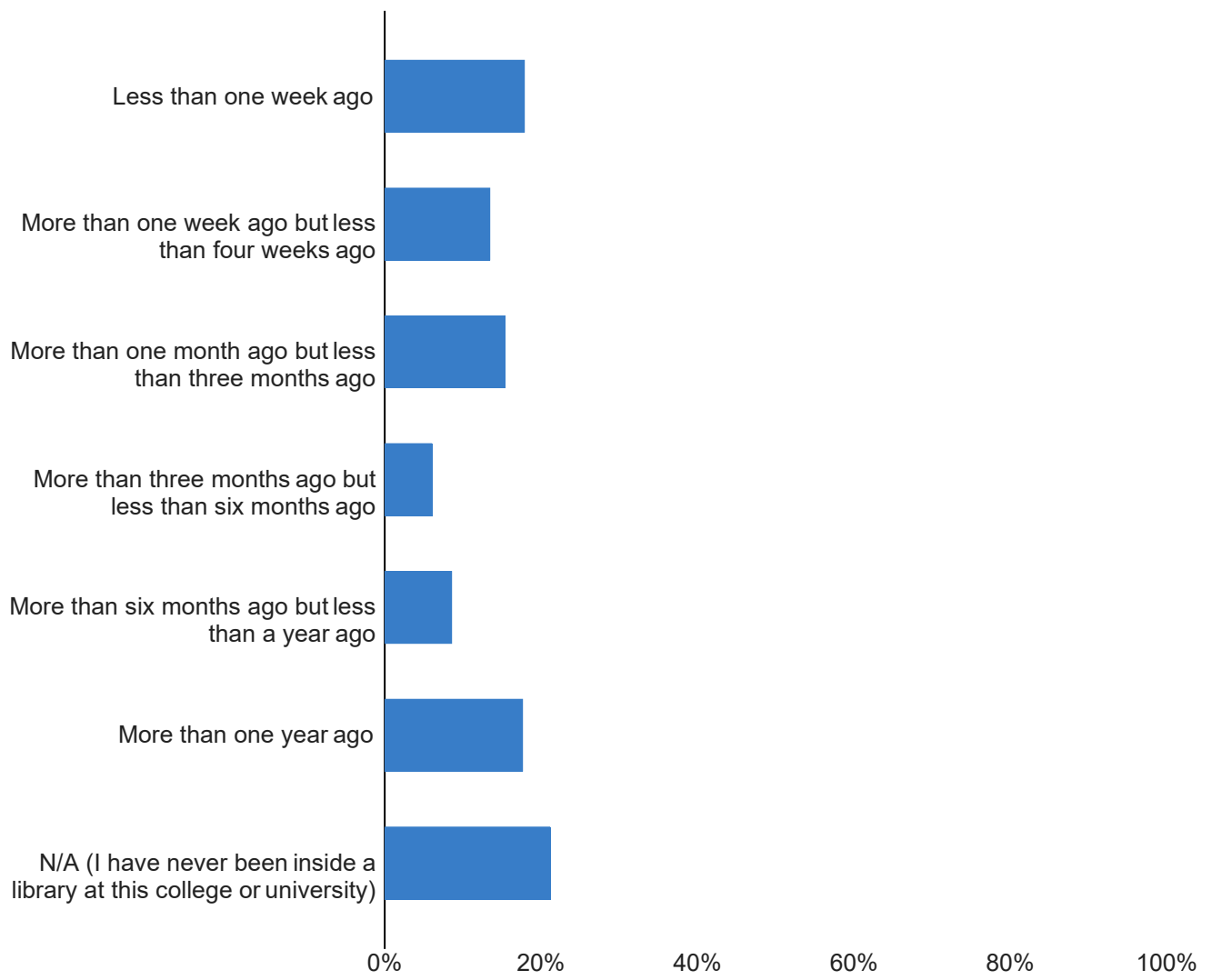

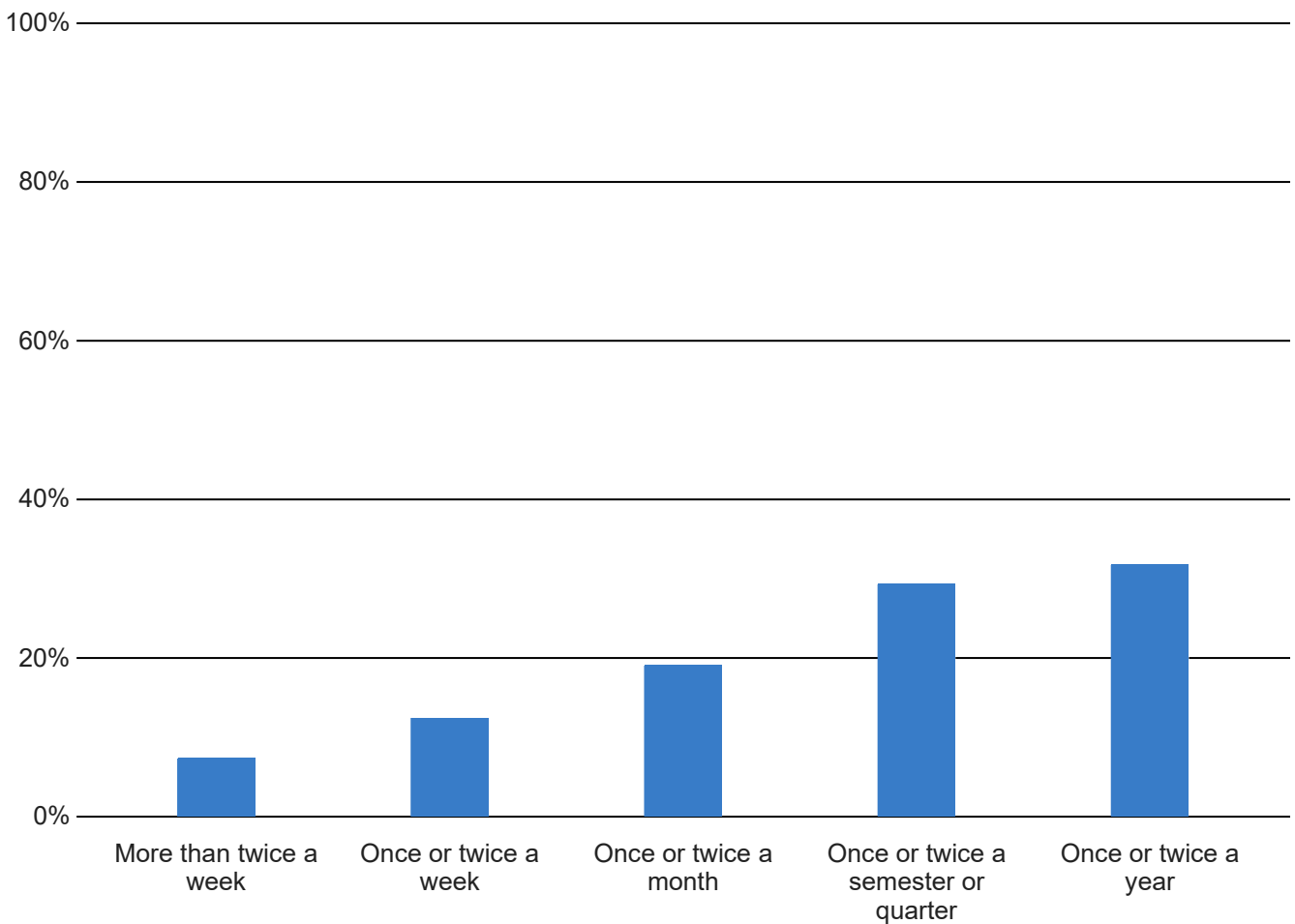

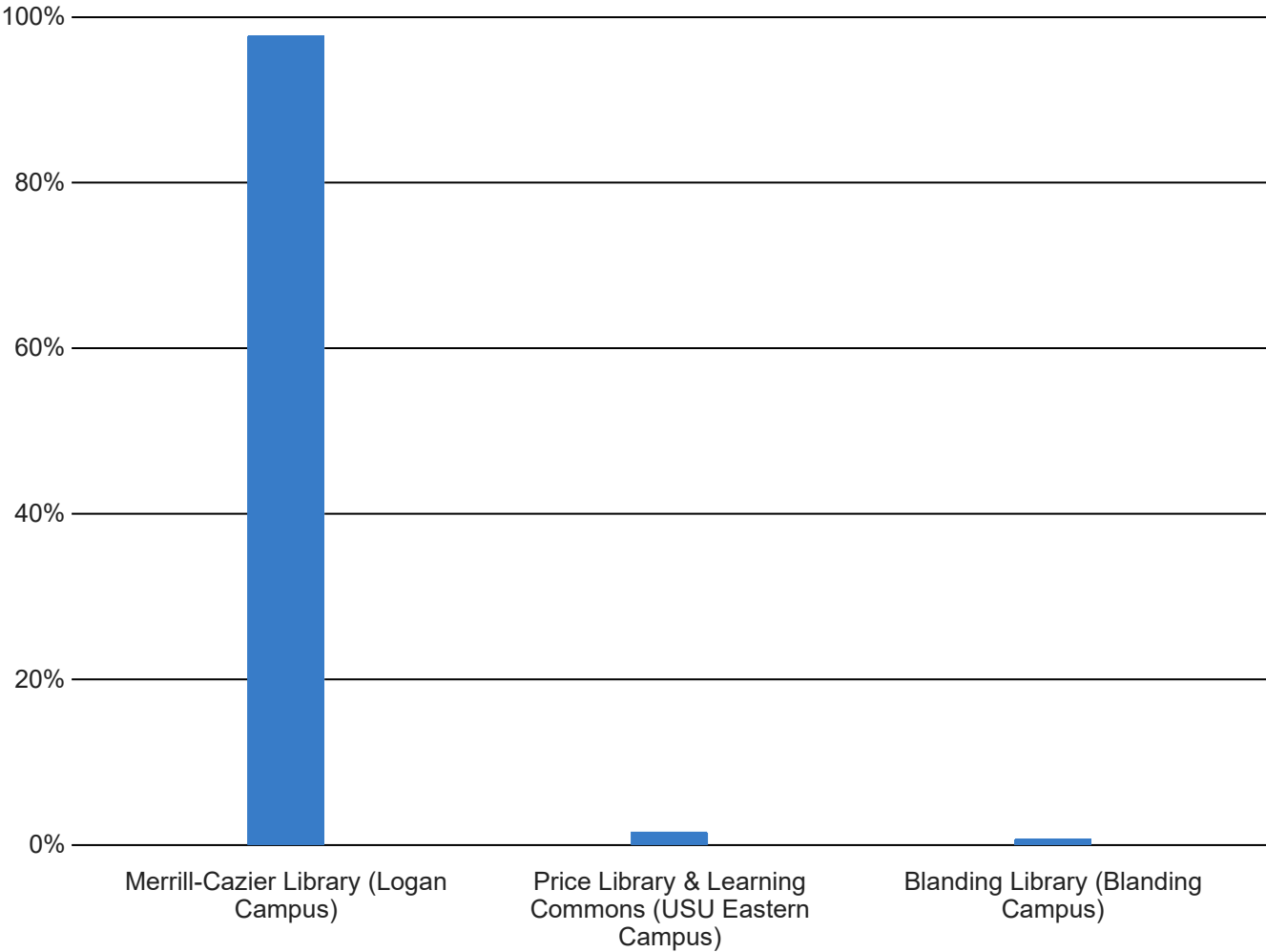

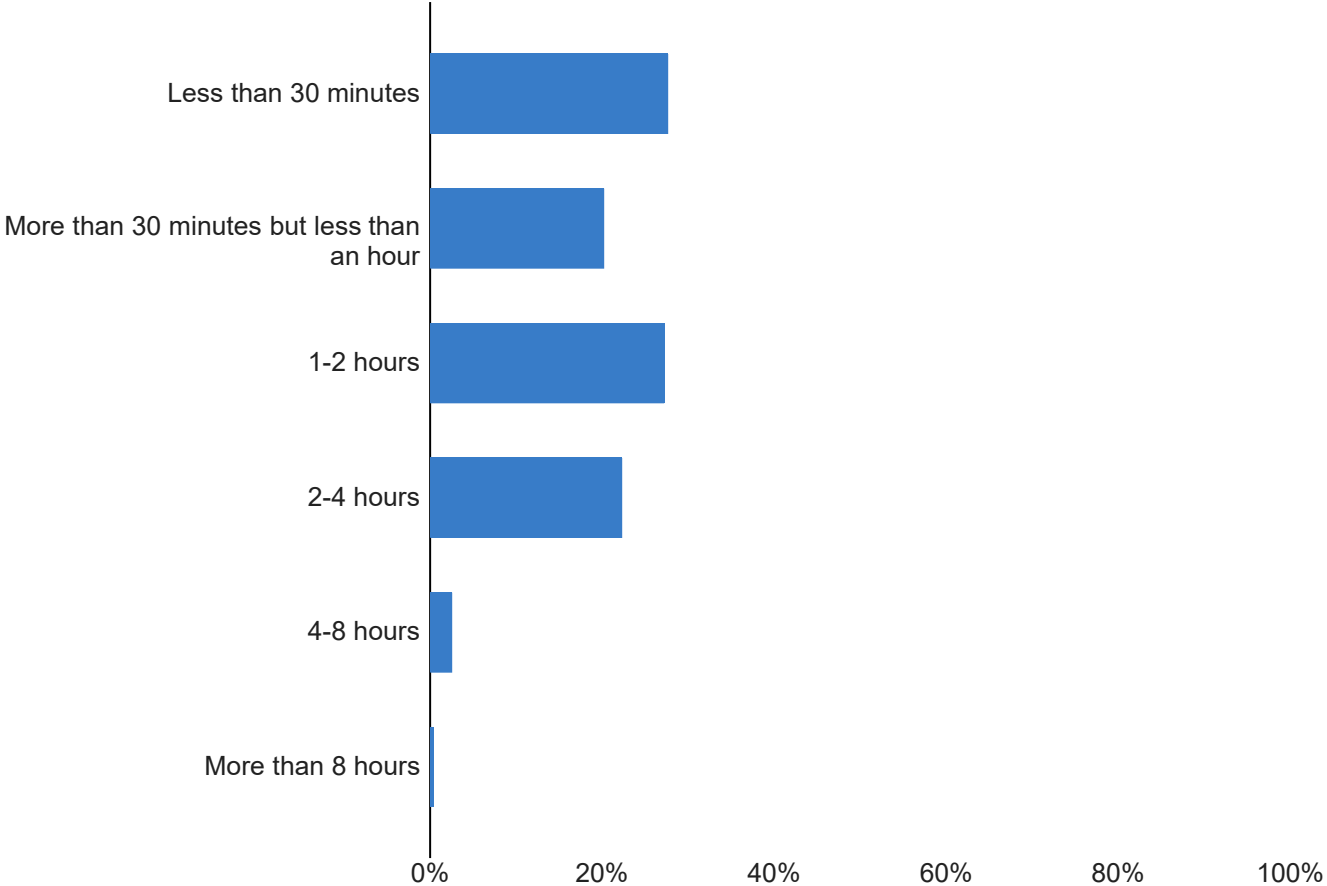

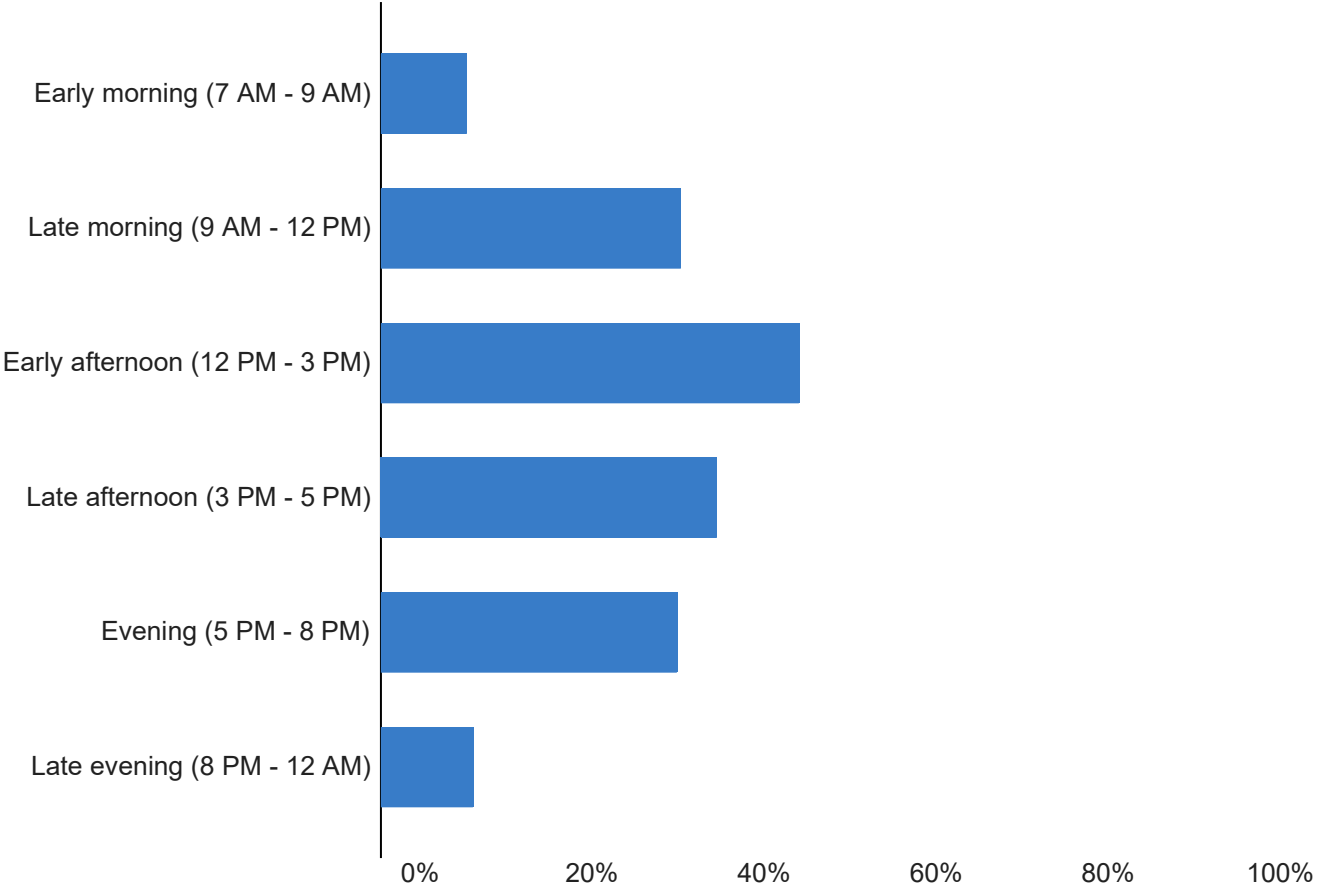

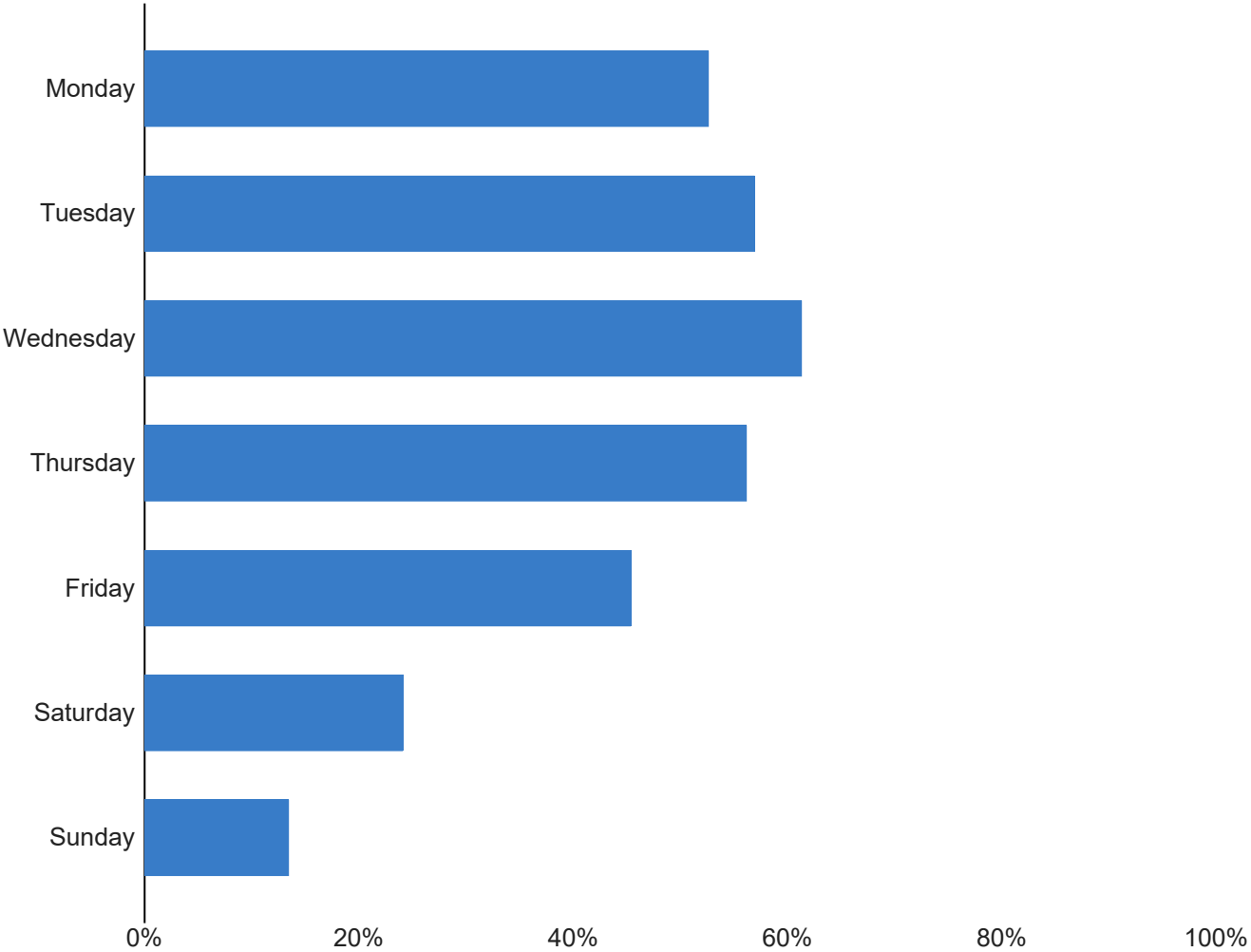

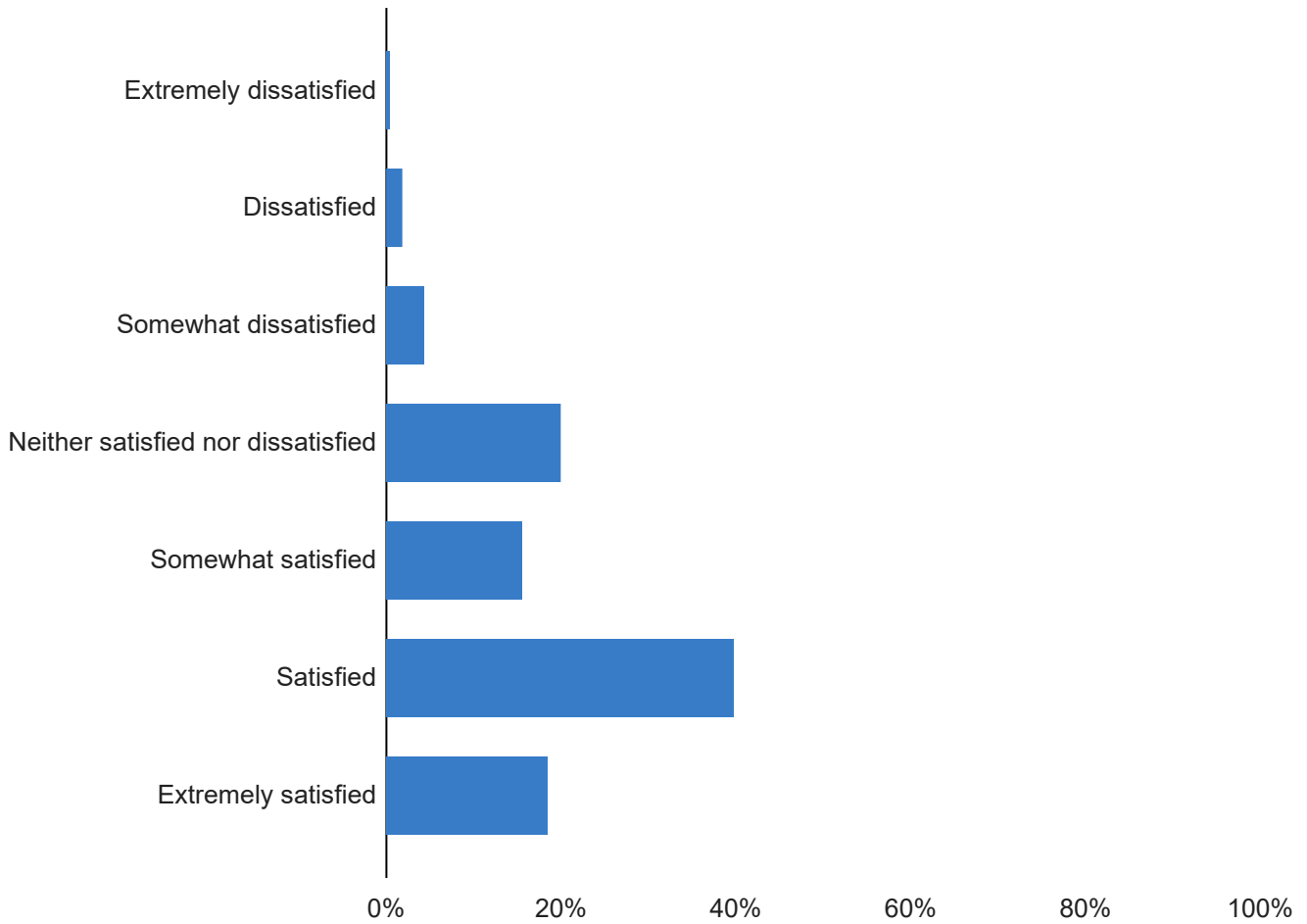

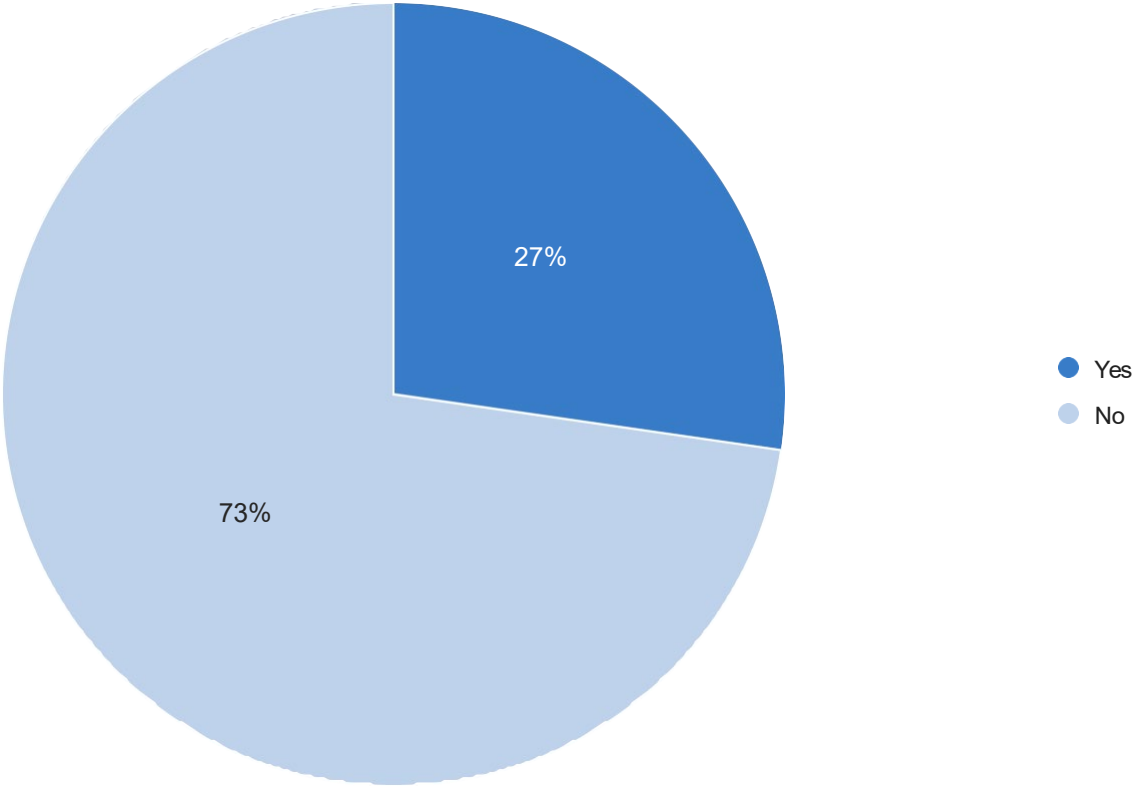

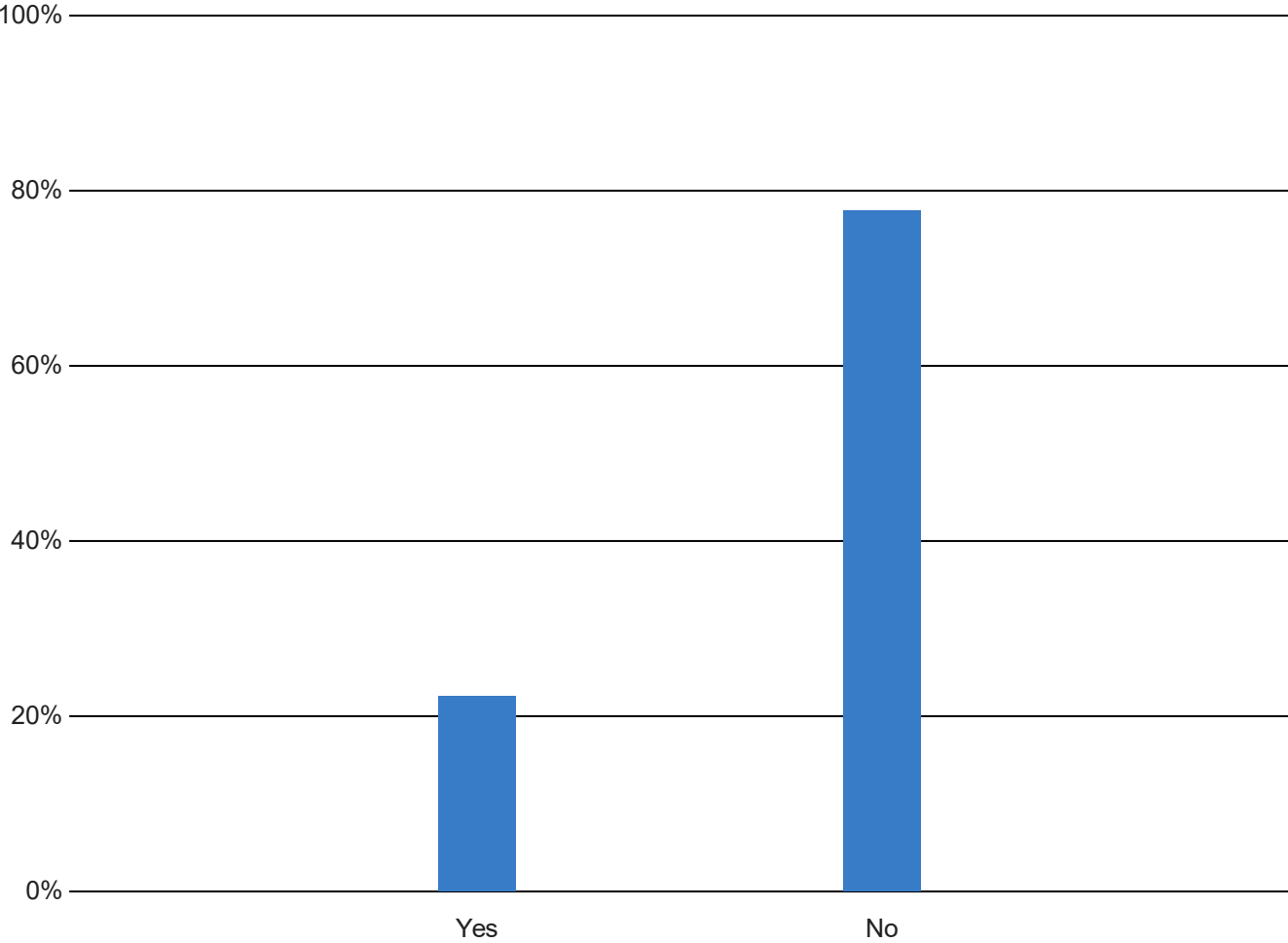

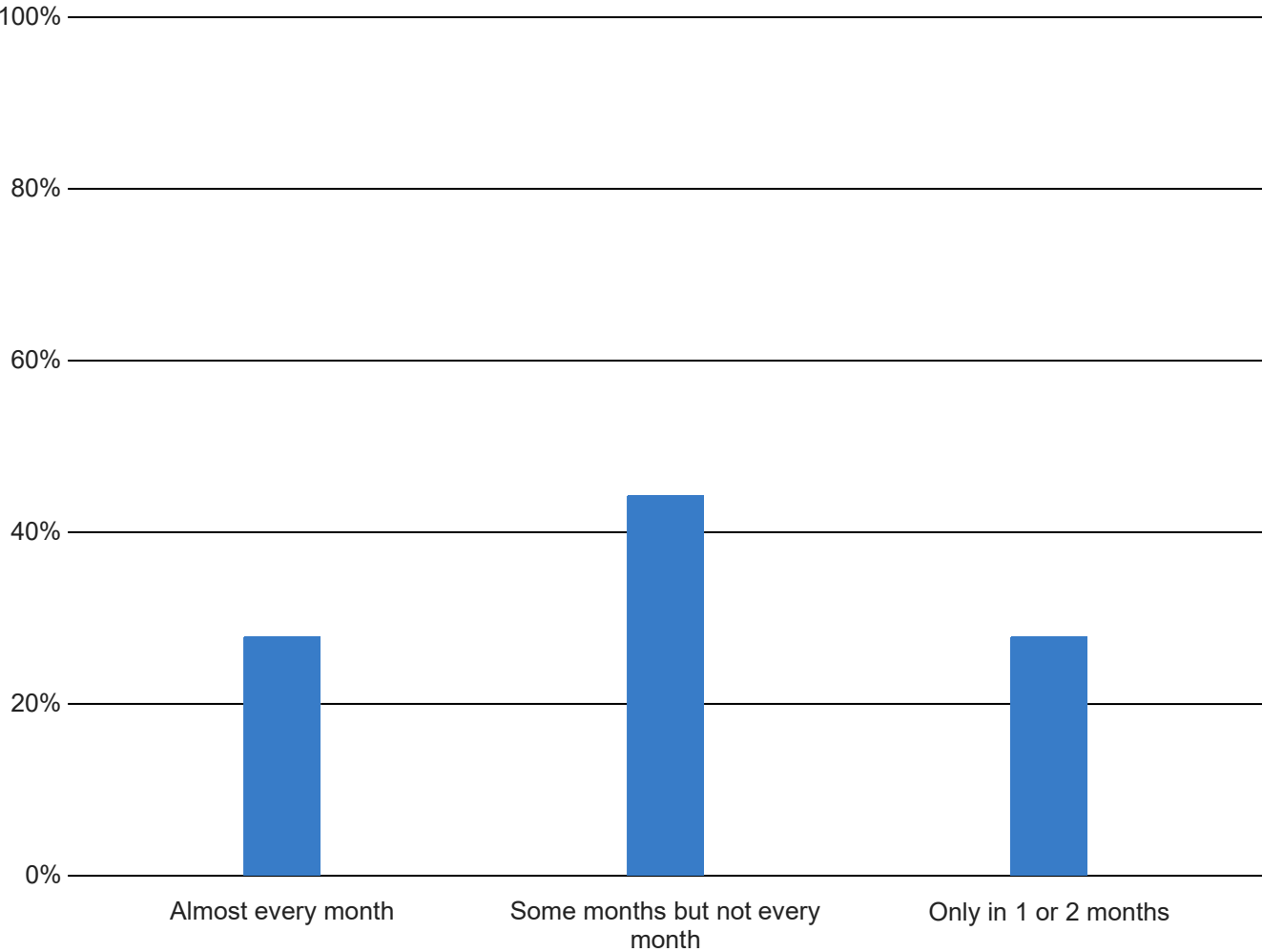

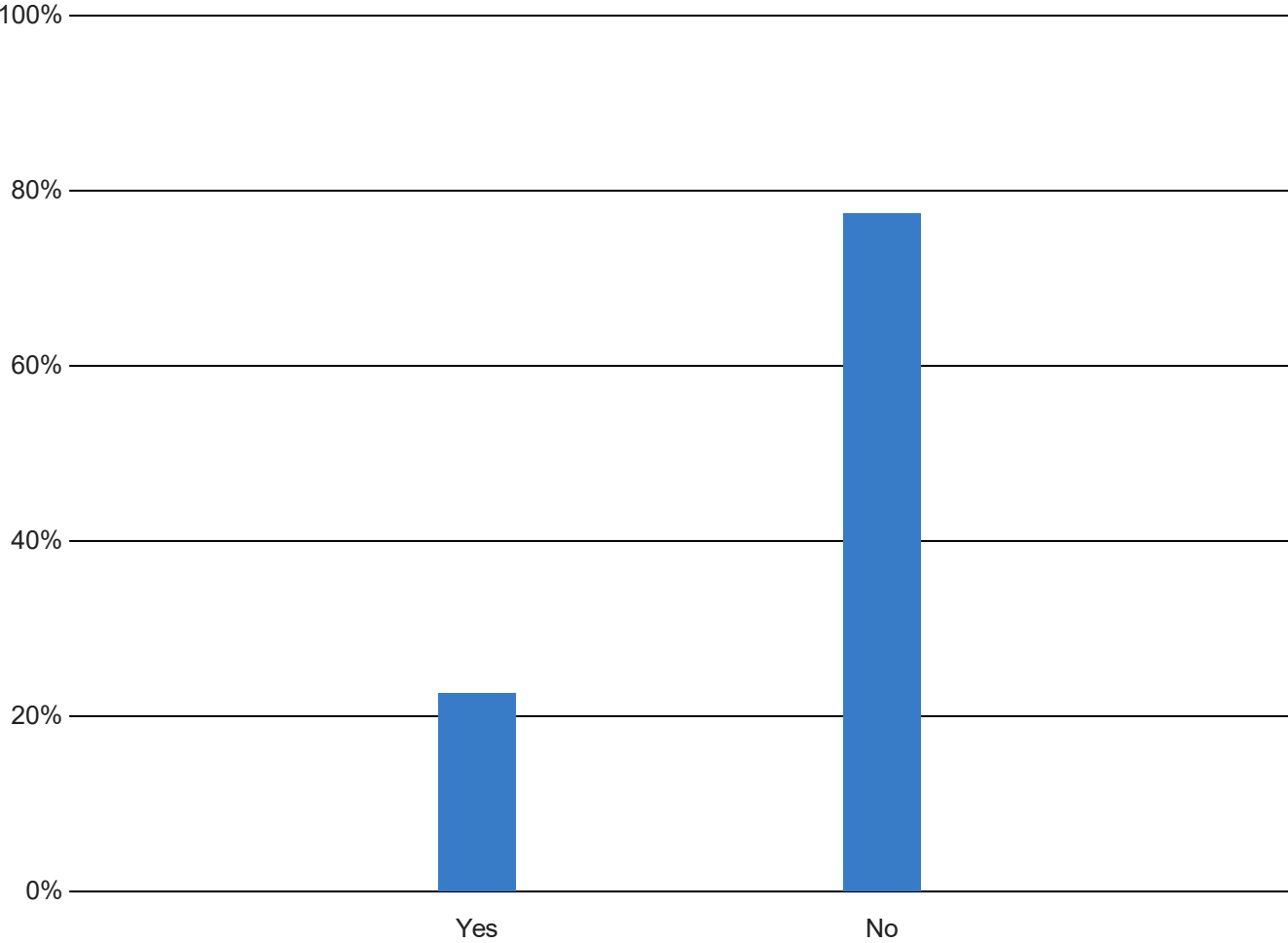

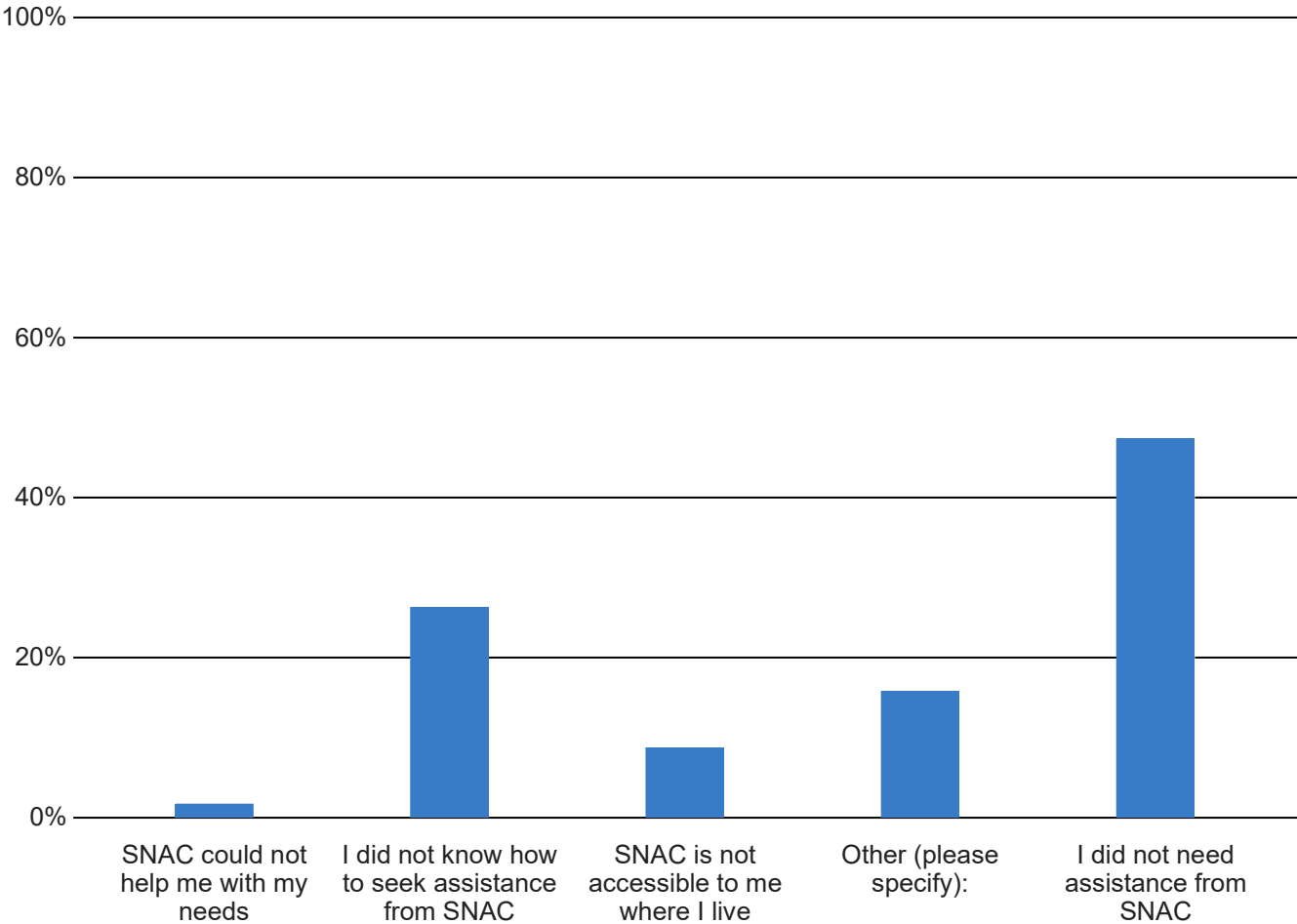

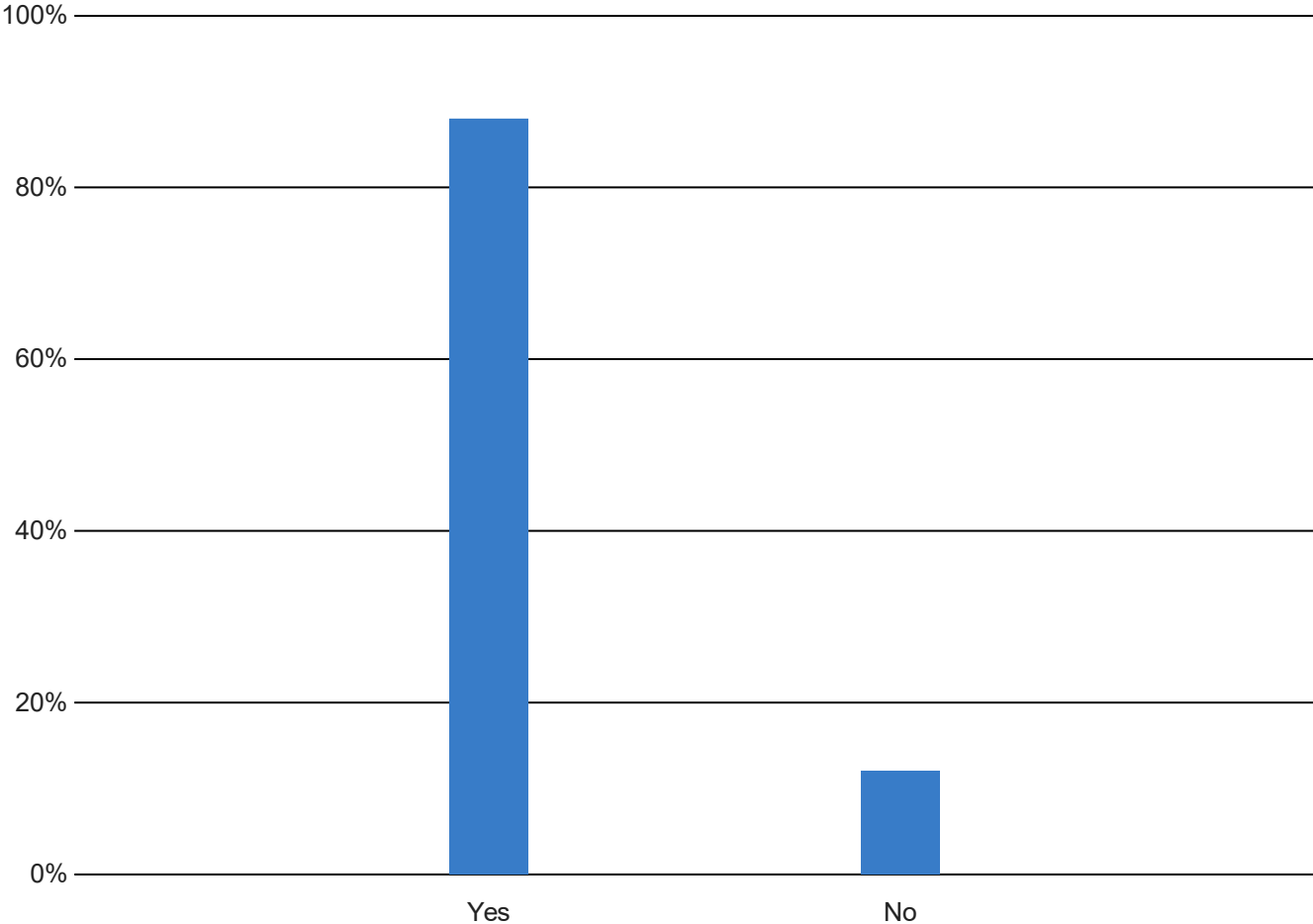

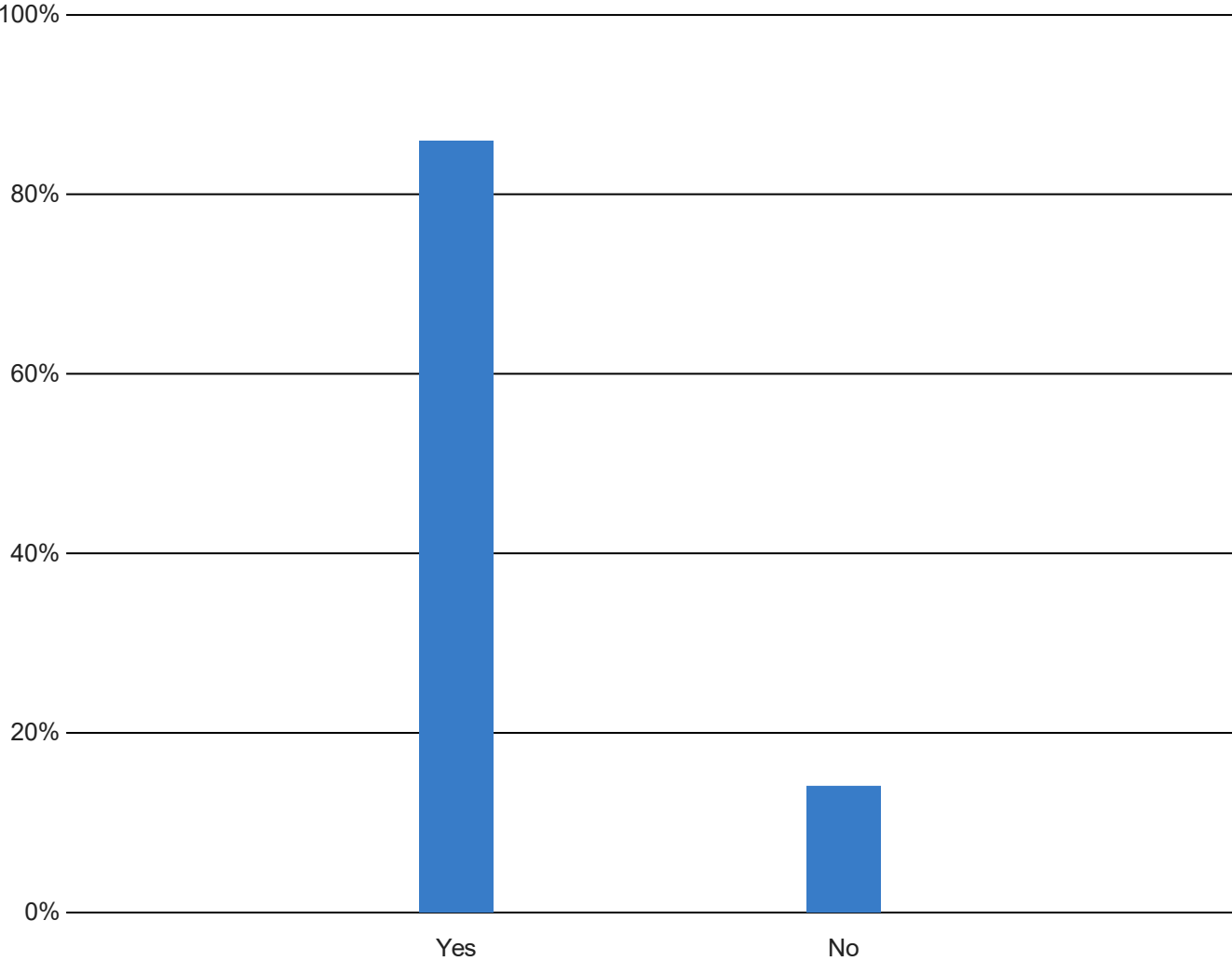

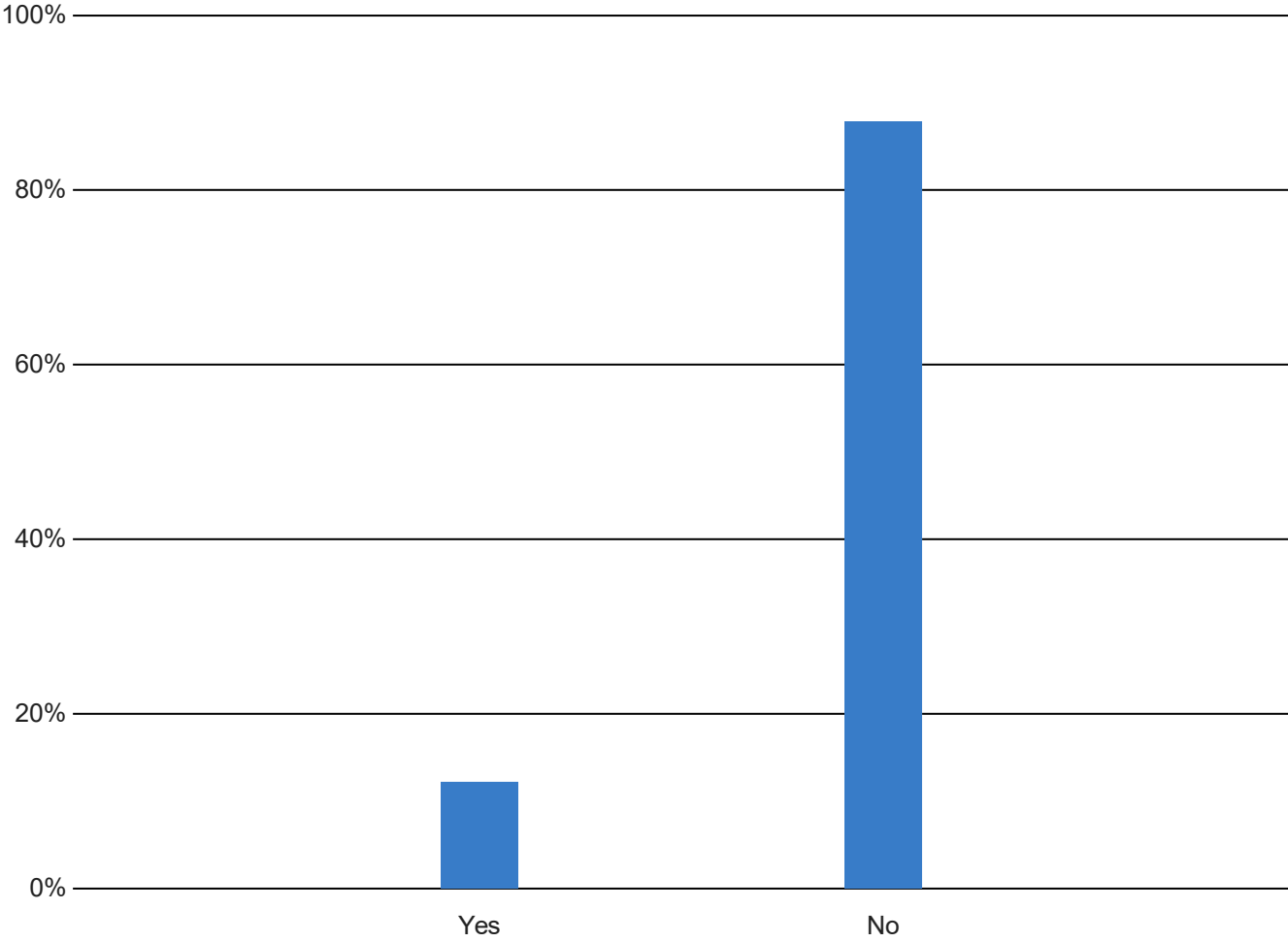

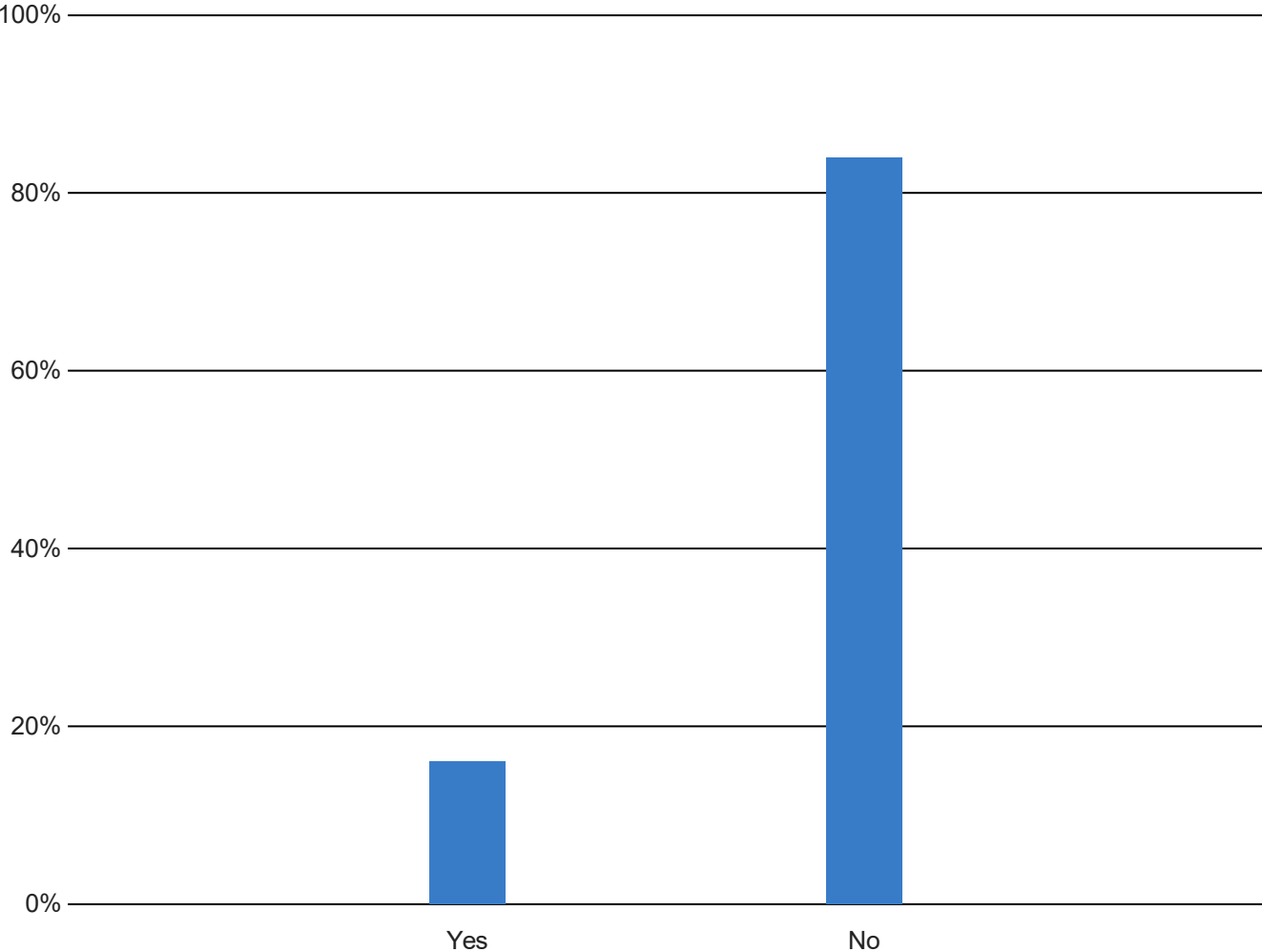
